This document addresses frequent questions received by the Applications Helpdesk relating to specific documents that should be submitted to EFSA as required by the relevant regulatory framework on active substances and products containing these substances. It complements information on the EFSA and European Commission websites.

The document provides informal general guidance. It is not legally binding and provides supplementary information to the prevailing legislative requirements.

\*According to Art. 6, the Supplementary Dossiers have to be provided to EFSA at the same time as to the RMS. However, for reasons of simplification it was agreed in the Pesticides Steering Committee (11-12/06/2013) to postpone the submission to EFSA until after the admissibility decision of the dossiers by the RMS.

\*\*As the pdf files need to be copied from the CADDY XML documents directory, they need to be identifiable as Doc P and therefore be named adequately.
