Draft Statement on Exposure Assessment of Food Enzymes

Note on the processing of personal data in the context of this Public Consultation

- The access to information collected in the context of this Public Consultation and the personal data therein is restricted to a limited number of EFSA staff under the supervision of the Controller, as well as staff of the IT Unit of EFSA providing technical support, without prejudice to a possible transfer to the bodies in charge of a monitoring or inspection task in accordance with European Union legislation.
- Your contribution in the EU language of drafting, is recorded in a secure and protected database hosted on the EFSA servers, operated in compliance with EFSA's Information Security Policy;
- Your personal data will remain in the database until the analysis of the results has been completed and will be rendered anonymous afterwards, at the latest one year after the end of the Public Consultation. The Controller guarantees that the contributions to the Public Consultation will be used in an aggregated manner and that the report on the results shall not allow the identification of individuals who have contributed;
