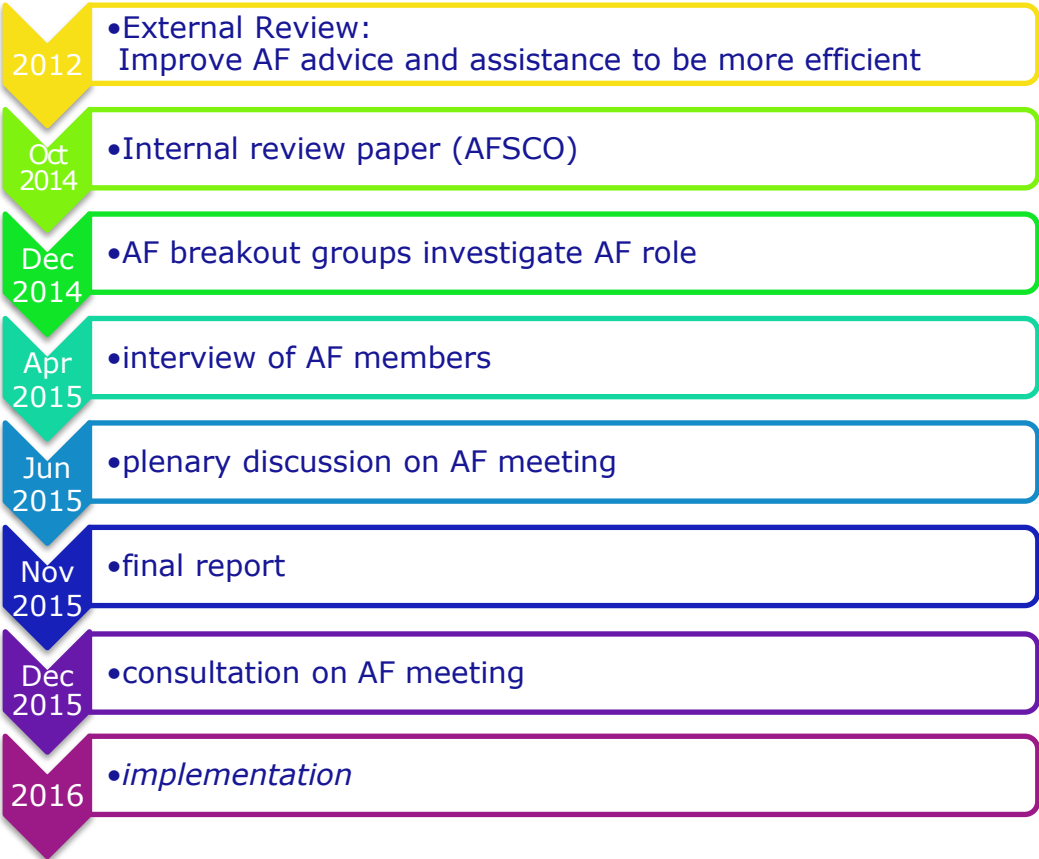

Advisory Forum to be :

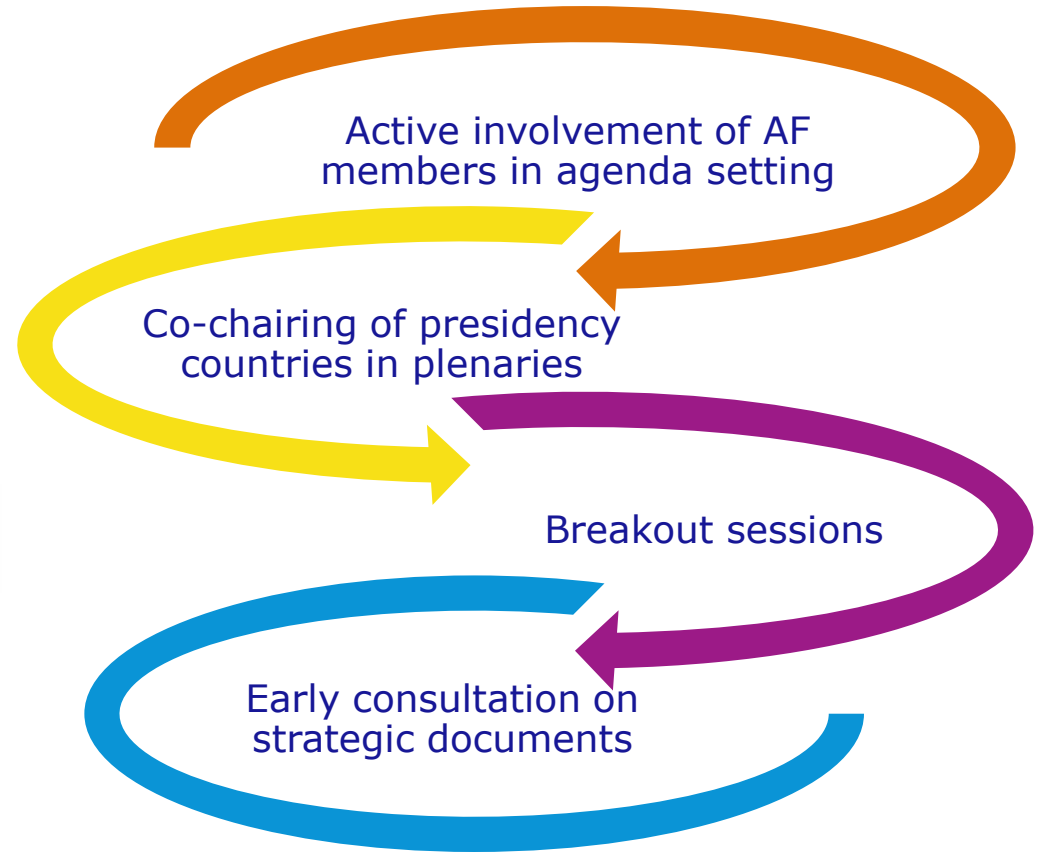


- ✓ **Steering Committee** EU risk assessment agenda

NEW *MODUS OPERANDI*

- 
- Members speak on behalf of country and commit resources, where needed, to priorities agreed in EU risk assessment agenda
 - MS with expertise to lead risk assessment (related) activities
 - Members identify activities/projects under different priorities
 - Identified joint activities/projects implemented:
 - small scale without need for additional resources
 - dedicating already available resources
 - supported by grants from EFSA
 - resources identified through other (inter-)national funding schemes
 - AF members asked to indicate which priority topics they dedicate own expertise and/or find additional (inter-) national resources

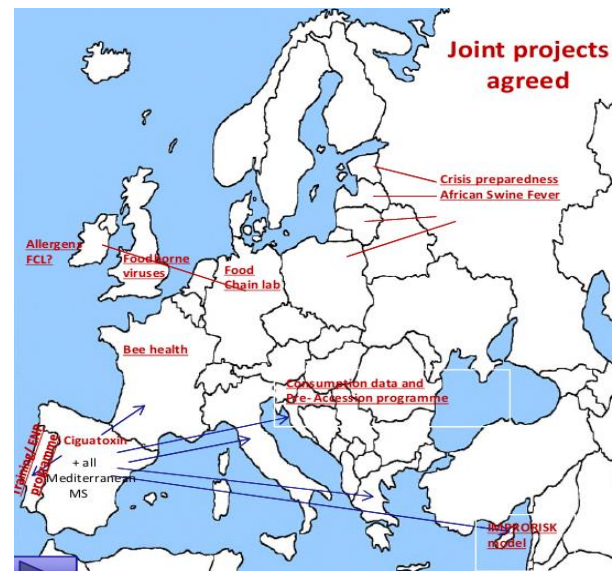
