PROPOSALS FOR MANAGING THE ONGOING PROCESS

■ MS interest

- to open the list to the AF members to indicate national interest;
- to receive concrete suggestions from MS to work on specific areas through written procedure;
- MS to take the lead and invest resources; and
- to open the list for registration.

■ Funding opportunities


- Mapping the funding at national, EU and International level
- FP in May 2016: Overview of national funding

■ Consultation

- EFSA:EU level external partners, NGOs after the publication, international after the national consultation



NEXT STEPS

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- MS to adopt a topic to take lead (at least one member per topic)
 - identification of interested partners to collaborate
 - work towards identifying activities through joint projects, forthcoming RA activities, annual work plan
