6.3 Re-evaluation of E 444 Sucrose acetate isobutyrate (EFSA-Q-2011-00530)

6.8 Safety of Trimagnesium dicitrate anhydrous (TMDC) as a food additive (EFSA-Q-2015-00460)

6.9 Re-evaluation of E 442 ammonium phosphatides (EFSA-Q-2011-00529)

9.1 Endorsement of the protocol for the systematic review of nitrosamines and nitrosamides (Sodium and potassium nitrite E 249-250)

The ANS Panel discussed the protocol and endorsed it subject to incorporation of changes as suggested during the meeting.

9.2 Titanium dioxide (E 171): new information

An update on the new data submitted from the Netherlands and on the outcome of the discussion held with the members of the FEEDAP WG on colourings was presented. Discussion and adoption of the opinion are deferred to an upcoming Plenary meeting.

9.3 Quillaia (E 999): new information

The rapporteur introduced topics for discussion to the members of the ANS Panel. The Panel agreed about the approach to be taken. Final discussion on the opinion and adoption are deferred to an upcoming plenary meeting.

EFSA staff informed that a complete technical report on the long term study performed by Ramazzini Institute on sucralose (EFSA-Q-2016-00251) will be made available to the Panel by the end of May.
