Update on Scuola per l'Europa / European School

The Scuola per l'Europa recently marked a major step forward by moving to the new seat for the start of the schoolyear 2017-18. The move is expected to help solving a number of issues and difficulties that the school has experienced since commencing operations in 2004. The availability of a well-functioning school offering the multi-lingual European Schools curriculum study was a pre-condition for EFSA's move to Parma in 2003 (as provided by the Seat Agreement between Italy and the EU) and is crucial to ensure that EFSA can attract foreign staff and their families to live in Parma.
