


PROJECT AIM

- Enhancing **engagement** of MS & competent organisations in networking




OVERVIEW OF MAIN CHANGES

- Structured summary of criteria compliance assessment & designation at MS level


Engagement




- Strengthen role and recognition of FPs

As-Is process





To-Be process

- No customisation – only configuration allowed





Competent Organisations grouped by Status


Number of Organisations for each Status


NETWORKING OF FOCAL POINTS
