## Risk Assessment & Scientific Assistance



### Panel on animal health and welfare (AHAW)

- Guidance document on GM animals endorsed. Adoption by the end of 2011
- Meeting of the Scientific Network for Risk Assessment in AHAW: data collection and data needs (14-15 Nov.)

### Panel on biological hazards (BIOHAZ)

- 4 opinions adopted: 1 on Food hygiene
  - 3 on Animal by-products
- 1 EFSA report published in collaboration with FEED, GMO, BIOMO and PRAS on EFSA approaches to risk assessment in the area of antimicrobial resistance
- 1 event report on a technical hearing with Freshfel Europe (STEC in sprouts)
- Meeting of the Scientific Network on BSE-TSE (29-30 Nov.)



## Risk Assessment & Scientific Assistance



### Panel on contaminants in the food chain (CONTAM)


6 opinions adopted: Opium alkaloids; Pyrrolizidine alkaloids; Alternaria toxins;
Tetrabromobisphenol A; T-2 and HT-2 toxins; Re-evaluation of acceptable previous cargoes for edible fats and oils – Part I of III

### Panel on plant health (PLH)

- 1 opinion on citrus originating in Florida imported in the EU
- 1 guidance document on environmental risk assessment
- Endorsed draft guidance document on 'Evaluation of risk reduction options' for public consultation
- Meeting of the Scientific Network for Risk Assessment in PLH (20-21 Oct.)

### Scientific assessment support (SAS)

 Training on Systematic literature review for Panel experts and EFSA staff (25-27 Oct.)

### **Dietary and chemical monitoring (DCM)**

- Guidance and Technical report on Total Diet Study approach
- Meeting of Expert Group on Food Consumption Data (14-15 Nov.)

### **Biological monitoring (BIOMO)**

- Contribution to the Scientific report on EFSA approaches to risk assessment in the area of antimicrobial resistance (with FEED, GMO, BIOHAZ and PRAS)
- Joint meeting with ECDC (27 Oct.): focus on E. coli outbreak in Europe and investigations on food-borne outbreaks in general



# Scientific Evaluation of Regulated Products



### Panel on food additives and nutrient sources added to food (ANS)

- Endorsed draft guidance on 'Submission for food additive evaluations' for public consultation
- Technical meeting with stakeholders on exposure assessment of food additives

### Panel on food contact materials, enzymes, flavourings & processing aids (CEF)

- 8 opinions adopted on food contact materials (3) and flavouring substances (5)
- 1 statement on bisphenol A
- Explanatory note for guidance on flavourings



### Panel on additives and products or substances used in animal feed (FEED)

- 20 opinions adopted in following categories: technological (6), sensory (5), nutritional (5), zootechnical (3) and coccidiostats (1), 70% of which are re-evaluations
- 1 guidance document on Toxigenic potential of Bacillus used in animal nutrition

# Scientific Evaluation of Regulated Products



### Panel on genetically modified organisms (GMO)

- 7 opinions adopted: Biogalactosidase from GMM; GM Maize MON 88017; GM cotton MON 1445; GM Maize GA21; update of the environmental risk assessment of GM maize 1507; the complementary environmental risk assessment of GM maize Bt11; and safety of pollen of maize MON810
- Meetings with applicants (11 Oct.) and NGOs (29 Nov.)

### Panel on protection products and their residues (PPR) and Pesticides (PRAS)

- 4 conclusions adopted on 4 active substances
- 1 EFSA scientific report in support of the revision of the guidance document on Persistence in soil

### Panel on dietetic products, nutrition and allergies (NDA)

- 9 opinions adopted on health claim applications
- 1 statement on the safety of glucosamine for patients receiving coumarin
- 1 guidance on the Scientific requirements for health claims related to antioxidant, oxidative damage and cardiovascular health
- Endorsed draft guidance on 'Requirements for health claims related to physical performance' for public consultation



## Scientific Evaluation of Regulated Products



### **Application Desk (APDESK) Unit**

- Operational since 1<sup>st</sup> October
- Acting as a "front office" and "support desk"
- 1st November: launch of APDESK function on EFSA's website
  - Web form to ask questions regarding applications
  - Frequently asked questions



- APDESK will be responsible for:
  - Centralising and processing the initial administrative steps of all applications
  - Harmonizing the templates
  - Developing IT tools to improve the efficiency of evaluation workflows
  - Coordinating public consultations
  - Registering and initiating administrative compliance check of dossiers
