Challenges in 2012



- Meat inspection, chemical contaminants...

- Application-related work:
 - Enzymes, Food contact materials, Feed additives, GM microorganisms, Novel foods...
 - Ongoing enhancement of services to MS, EC and applicants:
 Applications Desk
- e³ programme continues: full deployment of new organisational chart, re-engineered working processes, strengthened control environment

Key priorities in 2012



1. Further boost risk assessment capacity:

- Implementing the Science Strategy 2012-2016
- Further engaging national food safety agencies in work related to applications
- Enhancing internal and external scientific capacity (human capital strategy)
- Developing EFSA's Multiannual Plan

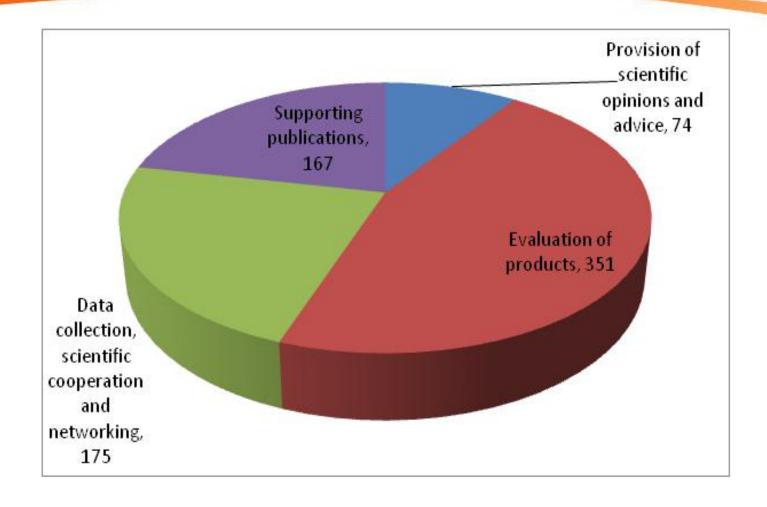
2. Fully implement thematic approach for communications:

- In line with the multiannual financial framework 2007-2013

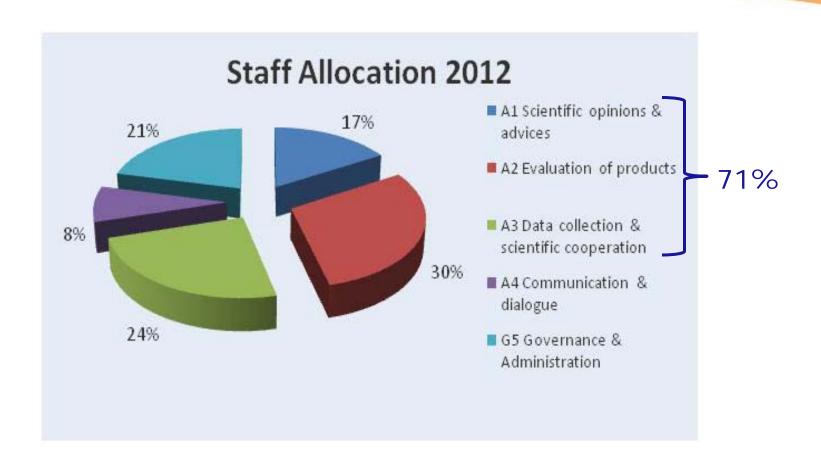

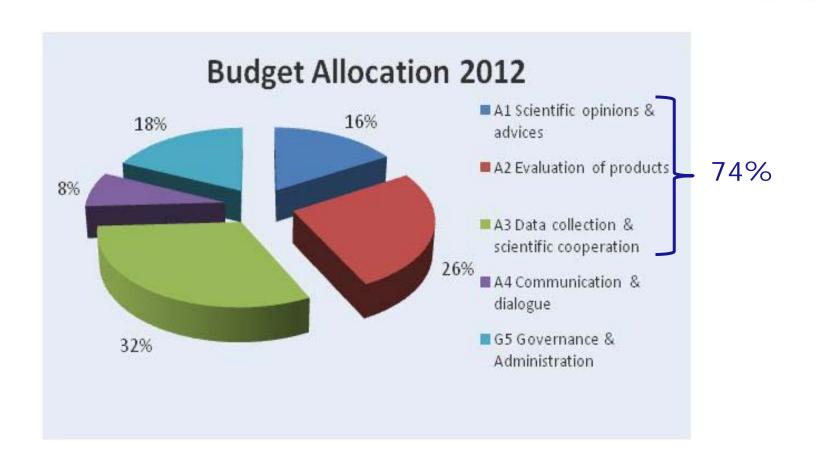

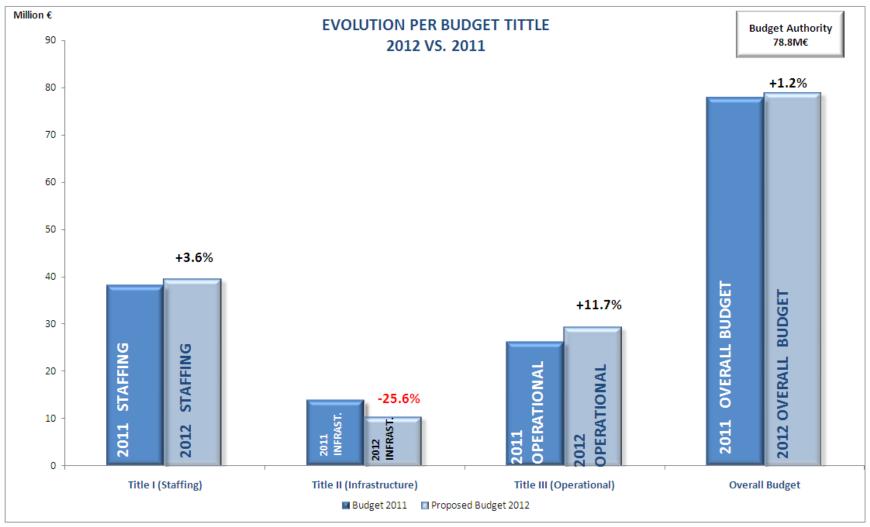
Budget Allocation per Activity in 2012





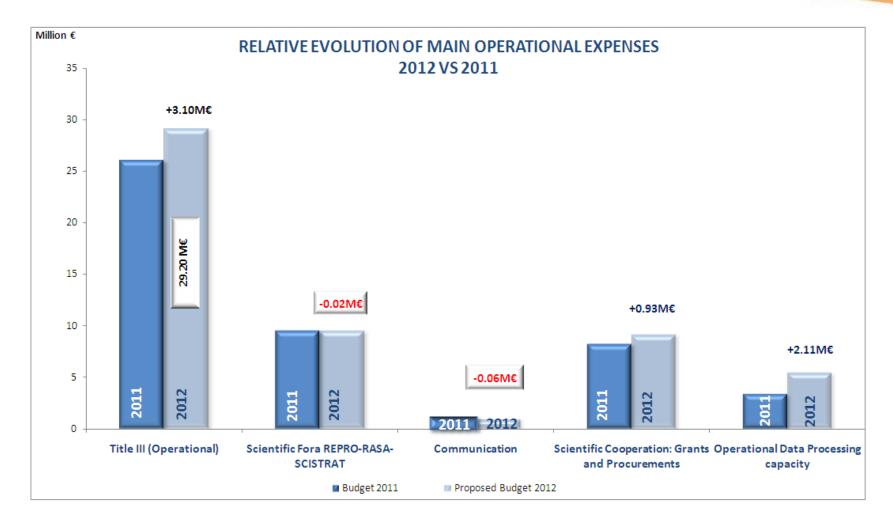
Budget 2012 per Title
