



EFSA preparatory work (1)





Transparency & Confidentiality

- Practical arrangements on Public Access to Documents (Aarhus) -> adopted by MB in March, published;
- Practical arrangements implementing the Transparency and Confidentiality requirements -> draft delivered by EFSA, now in consultation with EC
- Art. 32 Practical arrangements: setting up and managing the database of notification of commissioned studies; setting up and managing the pre-submission advice service; public consultations -> draft delivered by EFSA, now in consultation with EC

EFSA preparatory work (2)






- Review and update of 12 administrative & 17 scientific guidance documents in alignment with SANTE through sectoral meetings: work on going, expected adoption by fall 2020
- Preparing for the IT infrastructure to implement TR provisions, expected delivery by 12/2020, training until 03/2021:
- Customer Relation Management: Notification of Studies Database; Presubmission advice; Public access to documents; Public Consultation;
- Dossier eSubmission (FSCAP, IUCLID);
- End-to-End RA workflow, confidentiality assessment
- Secure storage and controlled access; dissemination; proactive disclosure

EFSA preparatory work (3)





- Support DG SANTE in relation to the establishment of the new Management Board (7/2022)
- Getting equipped to delegate preparatory scientific work to the Authority's staff
- Defining new expert engagement models
- New expert compensation scheme, addressing preparatory work and indexations gap

Engagement & Risk Communication

- ➤ Joint Steering Committee for Coordinated Risk Communication, established in December 2019 with EC and 3 MSs
- ➤ EC mandate for the provision of technical assistance in the field of risk communication, received and accepted on 25 of March
- ➤ The EFSA's expert Working Group on Social Research Methods and Advice has kicked off work to respond to the mandate through a scientific report on risk communication
- ➤ Benchmark, identification and agreement on future social media monitoring requirements, reached (pilot in Q3 2020)
- > TO-BE Processes linked to Public Consultation designed. Solution for technical management, identified
- > Explore suitable models to allow comp. organisations to support EFSA
