The Opinion proposes to update the draft UK guidance on aged sorption with the recommendations from the PPR Panel. After this update, the PPR-Panel considers the UK guidance document for aged sorption suitable for use in groundwater leaching assessment. The Panel considers the guidance suitable for both active substances and for metabolites of those substances when metabolite-dosed studies are applied. The Panel did not receive examples for the use of the procedure for field studies. For this reason the Opinion recommends further development and testing of the UK guidance for field studies. It is recommended to provide a user-friendly software tool that supports the entire workflow including the combination of higher tier and lower tier degradation data.
