# EFSA scientific advice to inform harmonised front-of-pack labelling and restriction of claims on foods

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#### The context in 2008



- □ Art 4 of Regulation 1924/2006 2008 EFSA <u>scientific opinion</u> on the setting of nutrient profiles (NP) for foods bearing nutrition and health claims
  - The purpose was solely for the regulation of nutrition and health claims made on foods.
  - Application of NPs should avoid that health claims mask the overall nutritional status of a food product and mislead consumers when trying to make healthy choices in the context of a balanced diet.

- Nutrient profile: the nutrient composition of a food or diet.
- Nutrient profiling: the classification of foods based on their nutrient composition for specific purposes.

## The context today



- ☐ The Commission adopted on 20 May 2020 the <u>Farm to Fork</u> <u>Strategy</u> for a fair, healthy and environmentally-friendly food system, as part of the European Green Deal
  - The Commission proposals for a harmonised mandatory front-of-pack nutrition labelling and for the setting of nutrient profiles for restricting nutrition and health claims on foods
  - The F2F Action Plan: Q4 2022

### EC Terms of Reference to EFSA



- □ To provide scientific advice for the development of harmonised mandatory front-of-pack nutrition labelling and the setting of nutrient profiles for restricting nutrition and health claims on foods. In particular, EFSA is requested to provide scientific advice on the following:
  - Nutrients of public health importance for European populations, including non-nutrient components of food (e.g. energy, dietary fibre)
  - Food groups which have important roles in diets of European populations and subgroups thereof
  - Choice of nutrients and other non-nutrient components of food for nutrient profiling
- ☐ The mandate excludes developing a nutrient profiling scheme or advising on current profiling models already in use for different purposes.
- Deadline: 31 March 2022

 Protocol to define the approach for scientific assessment (WG/EC/EFSA)

- Interpretation of the Terms of Reference
- Problem formulation (identification of assessment questions/sub-questions)
- Definition of evidence needs for each (sub)questions
- Identification of sources of information/data
- Owing the tight deadline, EFSA will consider recent review publications and sources such as:
  - Published reviews on dietary recommendations for healthy diets based on evidence from human studies
  - EFSA's own work on e.g. dietary reference values and nutrient profiles
  - National food-based dietary guidelines in European countries
  - A comprehensive review of front-of-pack labelling schemes provided by the European Commission
