

Aim of roadmap for action





Provides a full understanding on ongoing activities, knowledge gaps, societal interests and concerns as well as collaboration opportunities and potential partners.



Provides a basis for prioritisation and decision making for high-value (> 1 million euro), multi-annual (>2-5 years) studies or project calls (grants or procurements)



(New approach methodologies in risk assessment)





NAMs

Main objectives

- to define EFSA priorities for the incorporation of NAMs in regulatory hazard assessments and risk characterizations of chemicals in food and feed
- to define a multiannual strategy for increasing the use of NAMs in EFSA human health risk assessment to minimise the need for animal-based verification studies
- the large majority of EFSA requests for additional data are based on NAMs by 2027

Main objectives

 to develop and implement a harmonised approach for the assessment of human health risks resulting from both dietary and non-dietary exposure to multiple chemicals by 2027


- AO decision: non-award as tender did not pass the minimum threshold required.
- Award criteria:
 - Understanding of the assignment and tasks required (not passed)
 - Methodology proposed for the implementation (not passed)
 - Project management and organization of the tasks within project team and respect of timelines (passed)
 - Risk management (passed)
 - Measures to guarantee the quality of deliverables (not passed)

Launch negotiated procedure under para. 11 Annex 1 FR




Themes of 2021: consultation
