1. Welcome and apologies for absence

2. Adoption of agenda

3. Declarations of Interest of Scientific Committee/Scientific Panel/ Members

In accordance with EFSA's Policy on Independence and the Decision of the Executive Director on Competing Interest Management, EFSA screened the Annual Declarations of Interest filled out by the Panel members invited to the present meeting. No Conflicts of Interest related to the issues discussed in this meeting have been identified during the screening process.

- 4 Scientific outputs submitted for discussion and/or possible adoption, updates on ongoing activities, new projects
 - 4.1 Comparative *in vitro* metabolism studies (EFSA-Q-2020-0055)

The Panel was informed on how the comments from Panel reviewers have been addressed in the finalisation of the draft Opinion. The Opinion was endorsed for public consultation by the Panel unanimously.

4.2 Statement on the active substances flupyradifurone and acetamiprid (EFSA-Q-2021-00159 and 2021-00160)

The Panel was updated on the status of the implementation of the project and the planning.

4.3 Opinion on the toxicity profile of PBA and PBA(OH) (metabolites common to several pyrethroid substances) (EFSA-Q-2021-00118)

The Panel and European Commission were updated on the WG composition, interpretation of the terms of reference and planning. In particular, it was clarified that the evaluation of human biomonitoring and epidemiological studies is considered outside the scope of the mandate.

4.4 Development of Adverse Outcome Pathways relevant for the identification of substances having endocrine disruptors properties (EFSA-Q-2019-00492)

The Panel was updated on the status of the project, including the methodology followed in the supporting outsourcing activities and achievements.

4.5 Scientific Opinion of the PPR Panel for developing Integrated Approaches to Testing and assessment (IATA) case studies on developmental neurotoxicity (DNT) risk assessment (EFSA-Q-2019-00100)

The Panel was updated on the status of the scope of the project, timelines and the methodology.

5. Chair and vice- Chair elections and Working Groups review

Election of the PPR Panel Chair and two Vice-chairs were carried out according to the Decision of the EFSA Management Board concerning the establishment and operations of the Scientific Committee, Scientific Panels and of their Working Groups. Antonio Hernández-Jerez was elected as Chair of the PPR Panel. Silvia Pieper and Christopher John Topping were elected as Vice-chairs of the PPR Panel.
