Trusted science for safe food

As of 27 March 2021 new applications



- Subject to proactive disclosure requirements under the Transparency Regulation
- Transparency is the rule, confidentiality is the exception
- in the absence of confidentiality requests submitted with regard to information, documents or data supporting the application, EFSA will make proactively available to the public the entire dossier including all information, documents and data submitted once an application is considered admissible
- EFSA publishes the application as received once declared admissible
- Confidentiality decision making starts after admissibility

RMS / EMS proactive role key in admissibility phase to verify:


- A. Correct submission of attachments
- B. Personal data claimed confidential and sanitised
- C. Identification of the information claimed confidential
- D. Compliant justifications

Table 2.1. Confidentiality requests

The Confidentiality Report allows the applicant / MS / EFSA to identify:

- 1) the IUCLID sub-sections and/ or fields where a confidentiality flag has been set (with hyperlink)
- 2) the corresponding justification provided

A. Submission of attachments - 1



If there is no confidentiality request

- For each attachment submitted, there must always be a public version under 'Attached (sanitised) documents for publication'
- If no CRs are submitted, no other version of the attachment than the public version is to be submitted
- The field for confidential attachments ('Attached confidential document') is to be used only if the applicant submits a corresponding CR

A. Submission of attachments - 2



If there is one or more confidentiality request(s)

- In addition to the public version, a confidential version must be submitted for each document including at least a confidentiality request,
- Applicants should box or earmark all information claimed confidential in the confidential version of attachments

B. Personal data



- Applicant must submit CRs for any personal data contained in the information, documents and data submitted [except Art 39e(1) GFL]
- When submitting CRs based on Article 39e(3) GFL, the applicant is expected to confirm whether the data qualify as personal data as defined under Article 3(1) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725

C. Identification of the information claimed confidential



- The justification must contain a clear identification of the precise field or attachment subject to the request referring to the exact page, paragraph and line or part, as appropriate, where the piece of information claimed confidential is located (for attachments)
- Otherwise, EFSA / MS will not be able to assess the claim

D. Submitting a compliant justification



Indicating the legal basis (ground) for the claim [Art 39(2) and 39e GFL and, as appropriate, Art 63(2)(b) to (d) PPPR]

Justifying why the item should be kept confidential based on all below elements (except for personal data):

- Information not publicly available
- Potential harm to a significant degree
 - Information acquired legitimately
 - Negligible harm rebuttable presumption
 - Novelty rebuttable presumption
- Environmental information?

Next Steps



- Proposal for confidentiality assessment workflow for EFSA to be proposed to process requests received via IUCLID
- Changes on filtering rules to ease submission and assessment of certain Personal Data
- Business case to look into possibility for further adapting filtering and flagging features

Timeline: by 16 October

- PSN members screening applications kindly asked to perform a light check on the presence of key elements in confidentiality requests
 - a. Personal data sanitised
 - b. For confidentiality requests submitted, background documents and
 - c. a justification should be present
- PSN members to share their suggestions in improving the confidentiality justification template currently available in IUCLID
- PSN members to share feedback regarding current filtering and flagging scheme
