For Applicants or partners not currently on the list, it is strongly recommended to may apply to be included, but they must be formally accepted and included on the Art. 36 list by the EFSA Management Board list before expiry of the application the deadline for this call for proposals for this call.

- Applicant and in case of consortium also its partner/s are involved in the execution of the project.
- Subcontracting, if any, is justified in the proposal.
