*Q: Can my laboratory at the University of Cyprus apply for a grant? Or do I have to apply as the main Investigator?*

A: You should check in the link provided below if your organisation is on the list of Article 36 organisations which can apply to EFSA grants. If your organisation is listed, you are eligible to apply for EFSA grants when published. Success in being awarded an EFSA grant will depend on whether your organisation meets the exclusion, selection and award criteria which are specific to each different grant call.

In summary, applicants must be citizens of a Member State of the European Union (EU), or of a country of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) or of an EU Candidate country. Experts from third countries may also apply, and will be considered, if the required level of expertise may not be found among nationals of EU, EFTA or EU Candidate countries.
