- To optimise the IARC coordinated open "question-response" discussion on Wednesday 21 Nov 14:30-15:30, we would like to ask the invitees to send us any comments or questions related to the proposed session agenda and/or any additional topics or questions relevant for the open "question-response" session to Dr. Nadia Slimani (<u>Slimani@iarc.fr</u> and a cc: to the meeting chair Liisa Valsta (<u>liisa.valsta@efsa.europa.eu</u>) before Friday 16th of November.
- 2) Those countries already receiving EFSA funding for the EU Menu preparation will be asked to give a brief presentation (8min+2 min) on their plans and progress made. If the country representative is not directly involved in the project, information should be asked from the research group carrying out the dietary data collection. - 3) Questions for the country representatives to be answered during the Roundtable on 23 Nov, 2012, morning session:
- Is a national consumption survey planned in your country in the next coming years? If so, please indicate the age range, estimated starting year and the estimated duration.
- Would the publication by EFSA of the raw food intake data at the individual level classified based on the FoodEx system be a reason for you not to apply for EFSA financial support for your national survey?
- EFSA has so far published two calls for tender for supporting national surveys in 2011 and 2012. What could be improved in these calls to facilitate you to submit an offer? (timing of the launching and deadlines of the calls, duration of the contract, financial support, conditions to be eligible to tender, or other issues).
- 4) **The EU Menu Status report** will be sent to the country representatives on 15 November to be discussed on the second meeting day.
- 5) Slides of the presentations will be available on the Extranet and paper handout will not be distributed. Presenters are asked to send their presentations (ppt) to EFSA to Chiara Guescini and Liisa Valsta before Friday 16 November.
