- **WHY:** EFSA is establishing a dedicated forum for technical exchanges on the use of tools related to the application of the Transparency Regulation

- **Objectives**
 - To enhance interaction
 - To gather feedback on the usability of the tools, available manuals and/or training materials
 - To collect suggestions for improvement
 - To present to users the latest improvements

- **TOOLS included**
 - CONNECT.EFSA within the following business applications: account registration, notification of studies, pre-submission advice, public consultation, AskAQuestion;
 - OPEN.EFSA and public dossier;
 - Confidentiality request and Submission Builder

▪ **Working method**

- 2 virtual meetings per year chaired by EFSA
- Questions between meetings: Use the channel AskaQuestion

▪ **Outcome meeting**

- Announced on EFSA website
- Publication: agenda, participant lists, presentations, short summary discussions and action lists

▪ **Composition**

- Registered Stakeholders: category Business and Food Industry (max 15)
- Other categories of EFSA Registered Stakeholders (max 6)
- Member States (max 8)
- Laboratories/facilities (max 2)
- European Commission as observers

▪ Timeline

- **November 2022:** creation of the EFSA Technical Group on TOOLS;
- **November 2022:** 1st meeting (kick-off meeting);
- **March 2023:** 2nd meeting;
- **October 2023:** 3rd meeting;
- **March 2024:** 4th meeting;
- **October 2024:** 5th meeting (closure meeting).






