Open.EFSA

- ▶ We have observed continuous improvements being made (e.g. exporting and filtering functionalities)
- ▶ We see opportunities for further improvements in order to increase efficiency of processes
- ▶ Continuous dialogue and opportunities for exchange are very much appreciated and we hope this will continue in the future

Opportunities for improvement

- No possibility to sort results properly
- Not feasible to conduct analysis of trends and derivation of statistics (e.g. not possible to track dates of submissions for all types of applications)
- Export function: the authorisation type, substance column, dossier received date for example are empty in the CSV file for Pesticide Peer Review NAS and AIR
- EFSA self-mandates are difficult to retrieve without knowing the exact topic to look for.
- For some entries, difficulties in easily identifying them, as their display is not user-friendly, e.g. the question number appears in the “subject” field
