ADMISSIBILITY DECLARATION – NOS INFORMATION

- The PPP Regulation establishes the <u>RMS/EMS</u> role in the declaration of the <u>admissibility of PPP application dossiers</u>.
- The Transparency Regulation has introduced the need for RMS/EMS to check the compliance with the obligation with the study notification within the admissibility step.
- EFSA is providing an extraction from the NoS database. However, EFSA will no longer provide comments on the NoS extractions. The NoS check is under the remit of the RMS/EMS, as defined in the TR.
- Once the RMS/EMS declares the admissibility of a dossier, EFSA will only check the presence of the set of documents indicated in the Administrative Guidance and proceed with the acknowledgment of the admissibility.



ADMISSIBILITY DECLARATION - COMBINED NAS/AIR AND MRL APPLICATIONS

- When a <u>NAS* (or renewal) and MRL applications are submitted at the same time (the applicant should indicate the link between the two submissions in the dossier header)</u>
- -> we recommend the MS to declare the admissibility of the two application dossiers at the same time: this ensures the confidentiality assessment will run simultaneously and EFSA will launch the public consultation on the two application dossiers simultaneously.
- When a <u>renewal and MRL applications are NOT submitted at the same time</u> (e.g. one of the two dossiers is received months later)
- -> the two applications can be processed independently.
- -> for efficiency reasons, the RMS might want to perform a combined evaluation (MRL application as part of the peer-review) and address the MRL evaluation with the DAR/RAR.
- * NAS and MRL are always declared admissible at the same time



ADMISSIBILITY DECLARATION - JOINT SUBMISSION/INDIVIDUAL SUBMISSIONS FOR THE SAME ACTIVE SUBSTANCE

- In the case of <u>Joint Submission/Task Forces for the same active</u> <u>substance approval (NAS) or renewal (AIR)</u>-> we recommend the RMS to send the declaration of admissibility simultaneously for the lead dossier and all members of the joint submission/task forces (providing all UUIDs).
- In the case of <u>individual submissions for the same active substance</u> <u>approval (NAS) or renewal (AIR)</u> (no agreement on the JS/TF reached among the applicants) -> we recommend the RMS to send the declaration of admissibility simultaneously for the individual submissions.
- -> this ensures the confidentiality assessment will run simultaneously and EFSA will launch the public consultation simultaneously.



ADMISSIBILITY CHECKLIST

- The latest version of the Admissibility Checklist is available in the IUCLID PSN – All participants - folder "Resources": <u>FINAL_Admissibility checklist for</u> <u>pesticide applications.docx</u>
- The admissibility checklist will be included as Appendix to the EFSA Administrative Guidance. The EFSA Administrative Guidance on submission of dossiers and assessment reports for the peer-review of pesticide active substances and on the maximum residue level (MRL) application procedure is currently under revision.
- We would like to highlight that EFSA is organising pre-admissibility teleconference with Member States to discuss any topic related to the admissibility check (dossier completeness, NoS information, light confidentiality check) and offer support. Please contact us via the FDP FMB (FDP@efsa.europa.eu) should you wish to receive such support.





- Check that information in DAR/RAR/ER are compliant with the information in the IUCLID dossier.
- Work is ongoing on the development of the use of the annotation tool that should support in the future the generation of ER and AR.
- Dossier updates received <u>during the admissibility</u> trigger a new NoS check.
- Dossier updates received <u>during the scientific risk assessment</u> by the RMS/EMS <u>do not</u> trigger a new NoS check --> No NoS assessment foreseen by the RMS/EMS at this stage.
