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Challenges - General

- Severe delays on admissibility due to:
 - Steep learning curve
 - NoS checks – moving targets
 - Confidentiality/Personal data/Intellectual property checks
 - Connection (VPN) issues
 - Finding documents in the template structure
 - Different numbering/titles than data requirements
- MS still often requesting dossiers also in the pre-TR format
- Building up knowledge of the IT system and keeping up with upgrades
- Populate IUCLID with pre-IUCLID submitted data (who, when, how)

Challenges – basic substances

Experience based on the few dossiers submitted so far

- Applicants experience difficulties in completing the dossier correctly
In particular:
 - GAP table is filled in incorrectly (point to consider: revise the manual to make it easier)
 - Information related to notification of studies is not correctly provided
 - General problems with getting the dossier submitted:
 - applicants contacted COM to ask if they can send the dossier by e-mail because of general difficulties with IUCLID
 - applicants contacted COM to ask for confirmation whether the dossier was received in IUCLID (no clear information from the system following submission?)
 - applicants informed on the need to employ consultant for assistance with IUCLID (whereas the submission was meant to be simple for basic substance applicants)
- The majority of the options in report generator are not applicable to basic substances

Advantages

- Dossier availability for authorities and stakeholders
- Ensure interoperability and dossier to be submitted, searched, copied and printed
- Centralised communication/notifications
- Centralised help desk and training materials
- Building up data repositories for future processes

Recommendations

- More agreed rules/checks (quality/business) are needed to avoid delays in the admissibility checks
- Better coordination between NoS information, checks and re-submission
- Early checks on confidential/personal data requests are needed to avoid delays in the admissibility check and publication of the content of the dossiers
- More report templates are needed also in less frequently used application types
- Users should collaborate with EFSA to refine report templates and then use them.
