

OPPORTUNITIES FOR PARTNERSHIP

- **▶ Grant on ERA methodologies for PPP of low concern**
 - Science-based criteria for considering data requirements;
 - Alternative methods for exposure and hazard assessment for PPPs



➤ Grant for Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA) to advance the ERA of PPP



FPA - ADVANCING THE ERA OF PPP

Set a partnership to help us addressing the following objectives:

- ➤ To understand pathway of **exposure** for application methods other than the standard ones e.g. precision techniques
- > To understand the **relevance** of exposure (i.e. can it be excluded?)
- > To quantify the exposure in the relevant exposure matrices/environmental compartments
- > To develop appropriate and up to date exposure models
- To link the exposure with the effects to non-target organisms by defining exposure scenarios for ERA
- > To have suitable effect models to be use in risk assessment
- > To start conceptualize the development of an ERA platform which will allow the integration of tools, methods and data from different sources



FRAMEWORK PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT (FPA)

The FPA will cover different areas and with specific grant agreement the aim is to address various needs that are clustered in 4 main areas, primarily to be prepared for the revision of the terrestrial guidance document e.g.:

- Collect and generate data enabling to further improve the current knowledge on the exposure of non-target organisms in agro-ecosystems
- Collect data on the hazard
- Identify innovative tools for assessing the PPPs effects at higher level of biological organisation
- Design an ERA platform
