WHY NOW?

• <u>Main reason</u>: To accommodate the ambitions of the <u>EU Green Deal</u>, particularly for the assessment of <u>beneficial effects for the environment and animal welfare</u>, which are now not fully considered.

Proposal for a revision of the **feed additives** Regulation to reduce the environmental impact of livestock farming

Evaluation and revision of the existing **animal welfare** legislation, including on animal transport and slaughter of animals

 To update/refine aspects of the Guidance that according to experience would need to be improved/modify


 Clarifications regarding functional groups not included in the previous Guidance or which need to be revisited

- 1 (n) hygiene condition enhancers
- 4 (c) substances which favourably affect the environment
- 4 (e) physiological condition stabilisers (from 2019)
- Requirements to certify the compliance of animal studies with the EU Welfare legislation
- Development of the concepts of Independence and Animal health
- Refinement / reduction of the number of animal studies
- Others (harmonisation between Guidances; insects)






