### Issues raised

- ❖ Opportunities for knowledge transfer to MS national authorities/research institutes from EFSA's projects and Panels' work
- ❖ Opportunities for national authorities to benefit from the EFSA scientific outputs
- ❖ Challenges in the domain of nutrition and food safety
  - data gaps in existing data consumption EU surveys  
e.g. lack of data for supplements and for specific age groups i.e. young children and lactating women
  - Adequacy of data quality of food consumption data
  - Need for harmonization of EU risk-based official controls systems
