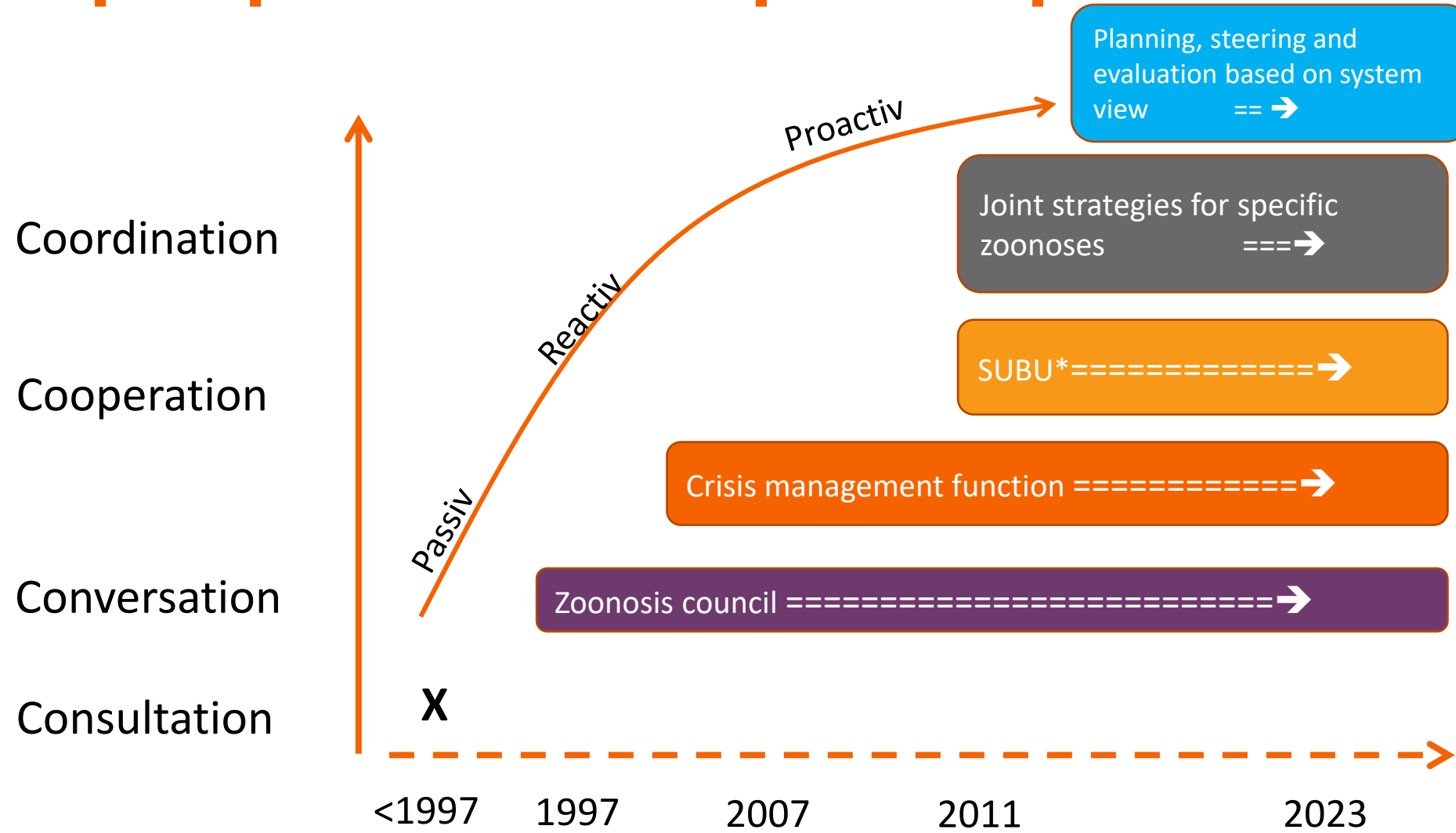

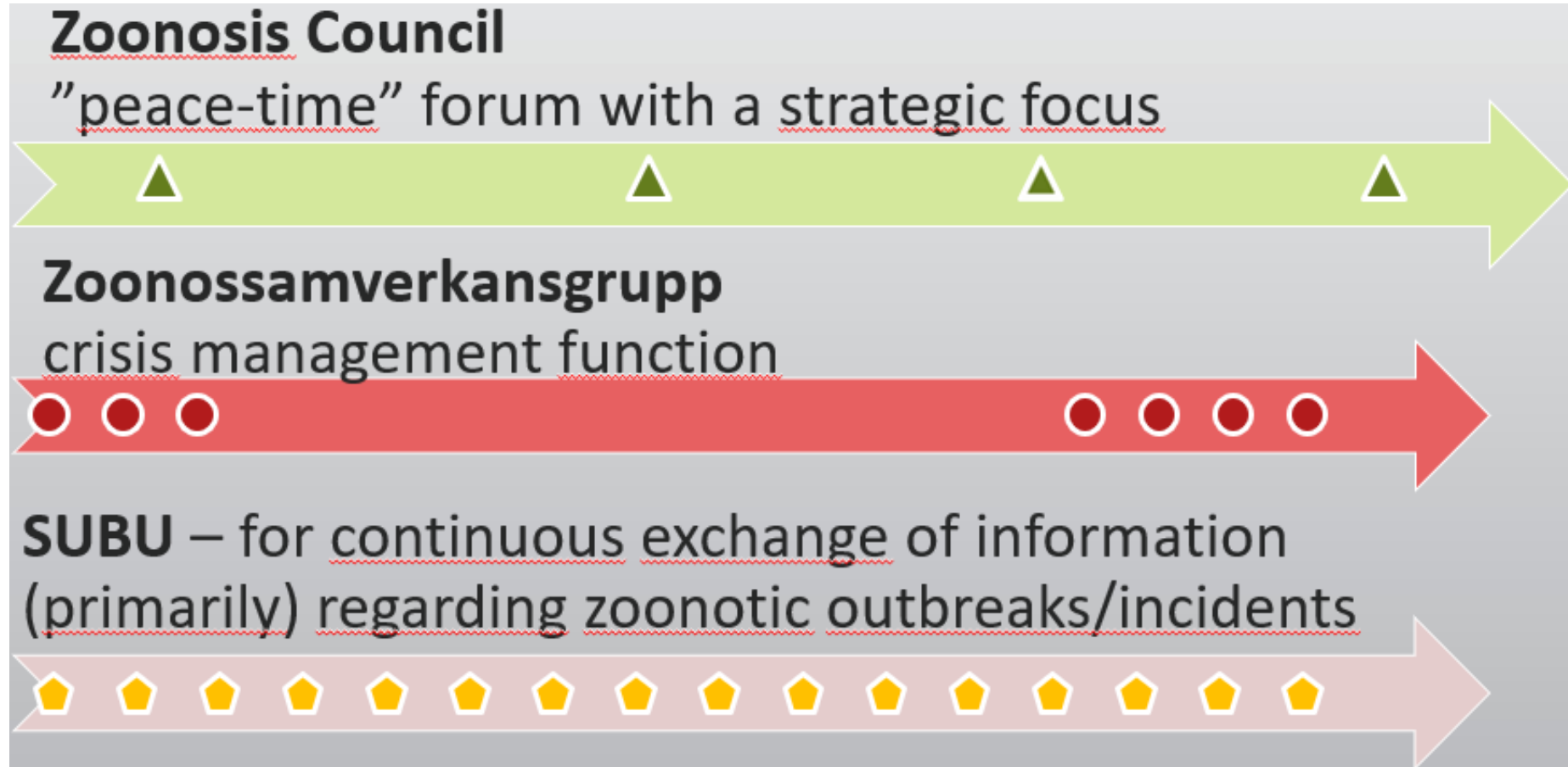

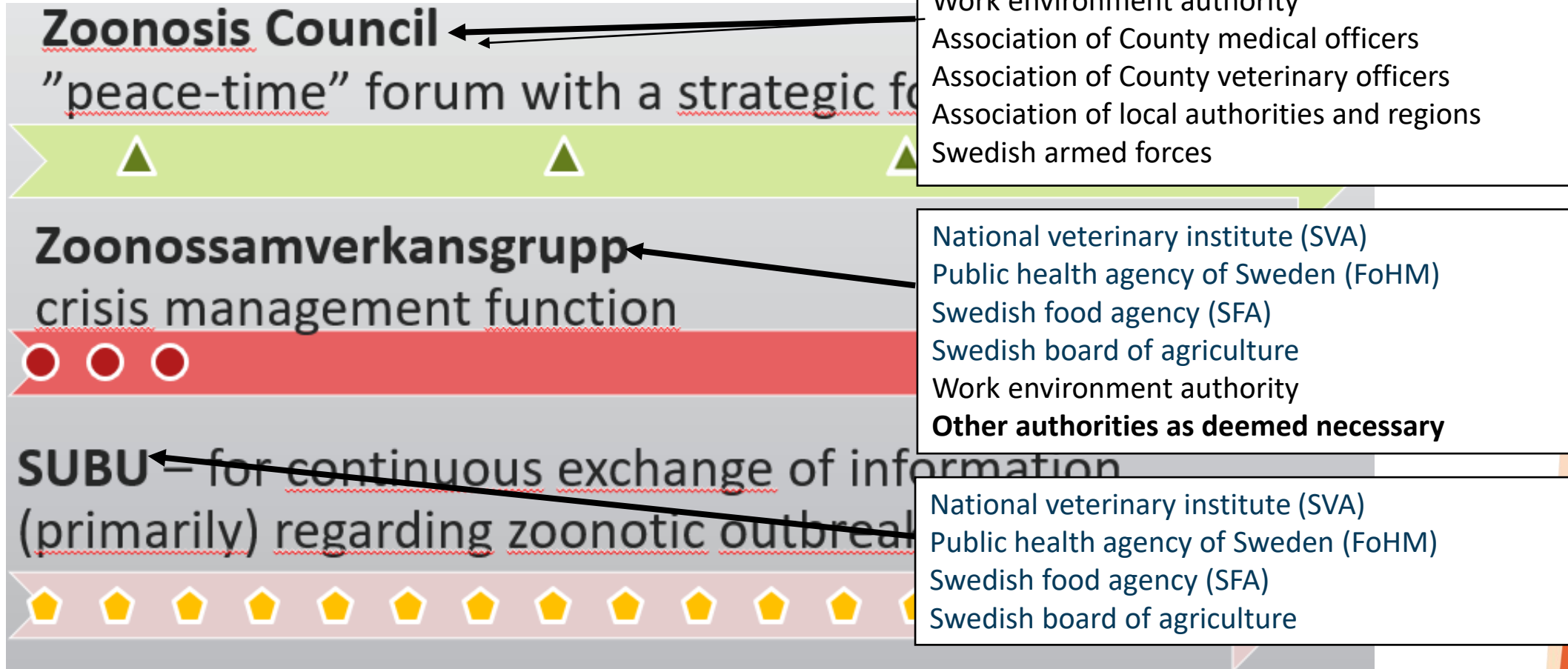

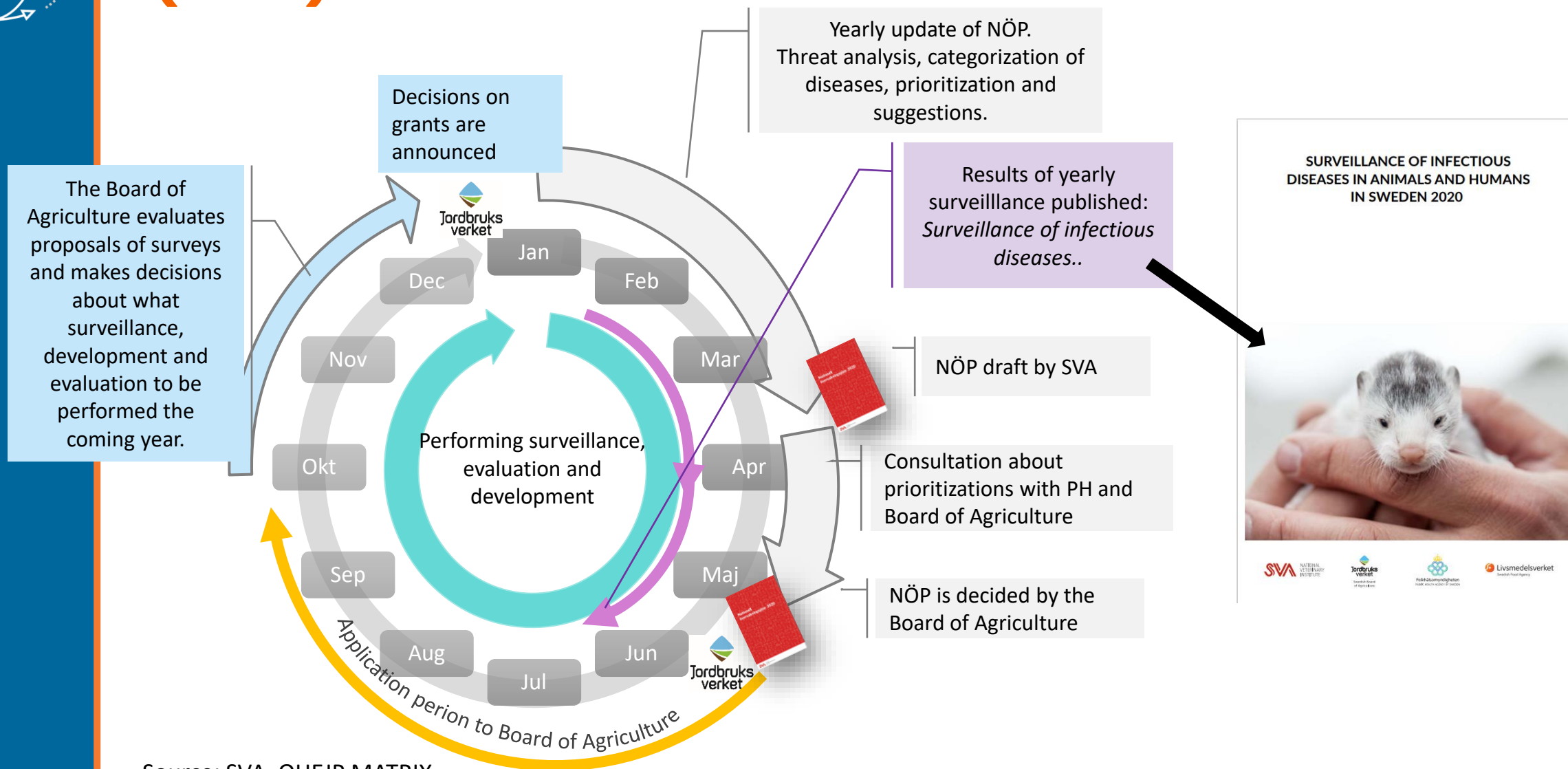

Good example 1: National surveillance plan (NÖP)



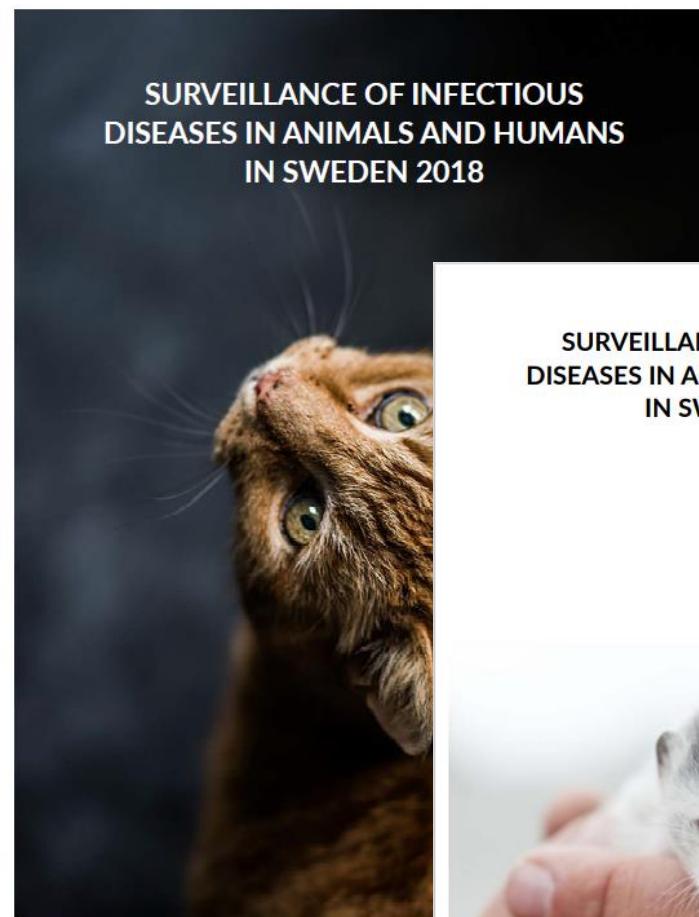

How, when and at what level is information shared between sectors?

Group/task	Type	How and when	What level
Zoonosis council	Strategic work	Meetings a few times per year	Aggregated data, presentations and discussions, meeting protocols are shared
SUBU group	Regular work	Regular meetings every other week	Aggregated and detailed info at individual/animal/farm level, diagram of WGS results, meeting protocols
Zoonossamverkan	Outbreaks or zoonotic events	Digital meetings as needed, email, phone	Details are shared as needed, meeting protocols
National surveillance plan	Regular/strategic work	Annual work by experts during spring	Expert opinions in documents, aggregated data, discussions
Surveillance report	Regular work	Annual work in groups during spring	Discussions, aggregated data, figures, tables, report published
