5. Draft opinion on the re-evaluation of behenic acid from mustard seeds to be used in the manufacturing of certain emulsifiers pursuant to Article 21(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 – for permanent exemption from labelling (EFSA-Q-2022-00042)

The comments received from the public consultation on the above mentioned draft opinion were presented and discussed, together with the proposed responses. The revised draft opinion including the annexed technical report which addresses the comments received from the public consultation, was adopted by the NDA Panel on 31 August 2023. The full text of the opinion will be available in the coming weeks in the EFSA Journal.

6. Draft opinion on 'Appethyl®' and 'body weight reduction' (Art. 13(5) claim). Applicant: Greenleaf Medical AB (HC-2022-3072_SE) (EFSA-Q-2022- 00096)

The draft opinion was presented. The Panel reviewed the sections and discussed the issues related to the characterisation of the food/constituent, the studies submitted for the scientific substantiation of the claimed effect, and the proposed mechanism of action. The opinion was adopted by the Panel on 31 August subject to incorporation of editorial comments. The full text of the opinion will be available in the coming weeks in the EFSA Journal.
