





The course covers key steps in dossier preparation and submission:

- Introduction to ECHA cloud services and IUCLID desktop/server

- IUCLID dossiers basic concepts: PPP working contexts and dossier preparation, microorganisms and Table of Contents, datasets, IUCLID documents, making a request for confidentiality and instructions for uploading attachments
- Validation of a dossier and actions in case of unresolved rules Report generator, overview of available reports
- Transparency regulation publication requirement
- Create and export dossier – light dossier export explained
- Submission portal



# THE PLATFORM

## Checking the completeness of a dossier

Before submitting a dossier, it is important to run validation assistant to check the dossier is technically complete. The rules applied included in the Dossier Header, make sure this is completed correctly. It is important to resolve all validation assistant warnings, this the evaluator. If you cannot resolve all the warnings re-run the validation assistant, download the excel file and include in this file the warning and provide this directly to the evaluator. Note missing studies for a specific data requirement/endpoint should be justified relevant endpoint study record.


If the report shows a business rule failure (anything starting with BR, e.g. BR\_PPP\_033) this will prevent the applicant from success report shows a validation warning (anything starting with QLT, e.g. QLT\_PPP\_001) the applicant will be able to submit the dossier to admissibility check.
