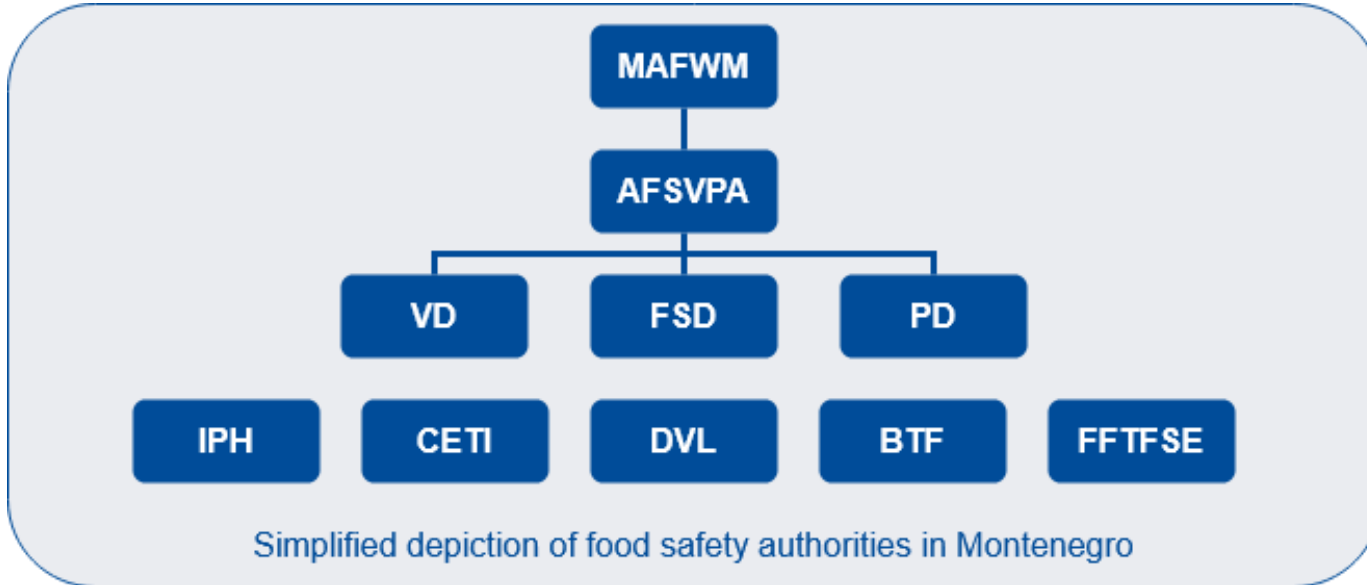

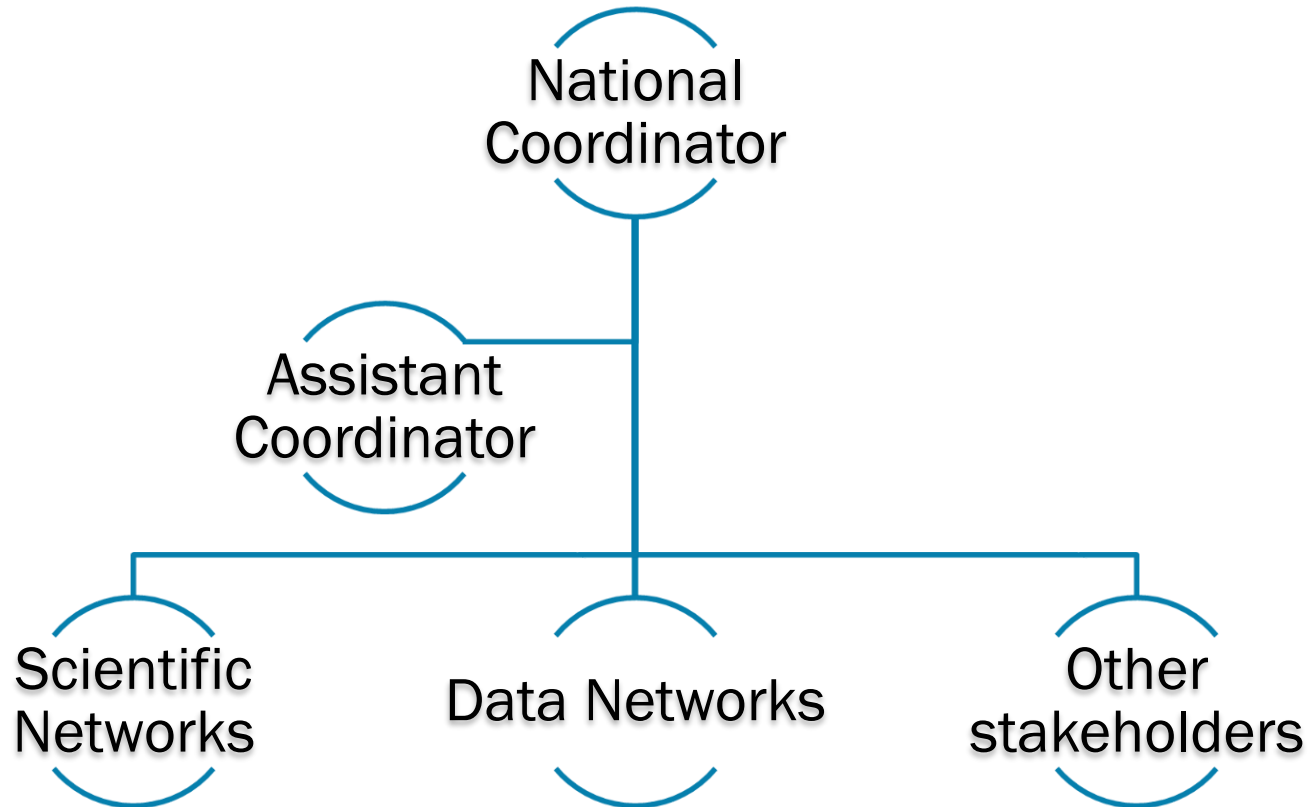
NATIONAL FOOD SAFETY STRUCTURE

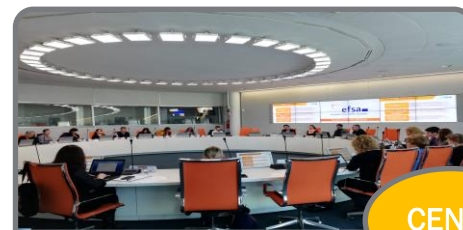

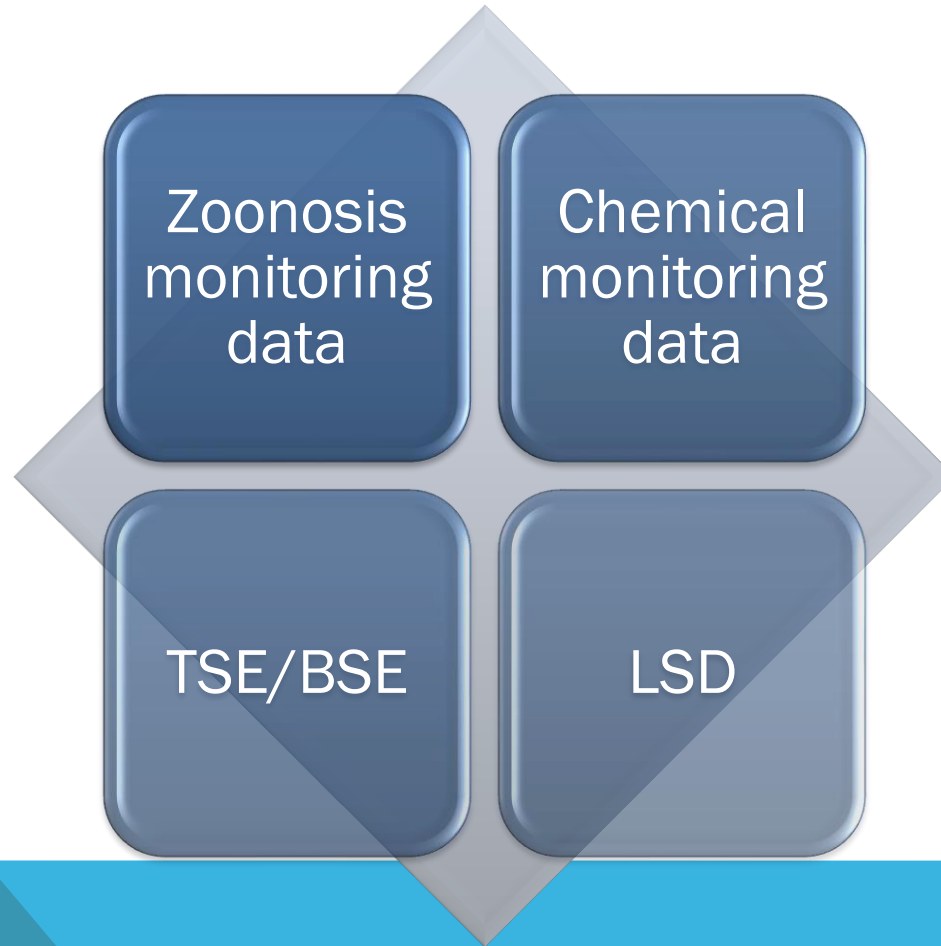

U Crnoj Gori nije registrovan ni jedan slučaj afričke kuge svinja, ali, kako kaže, Dejan Laušević iz Veterinarske laboratorije, pitanje je trenutka kada će se to desiti, budući da je bolest registrovana u svim ostalim zemljama svijeta.



Crna Gora se pridružila Evropskoj agenciji za bezbjednost hrane u borbi protiv afričke kuge svinja

Evropska agencija za bezbjednost hrane (EFSA) zajedno sa Ministarstvom poljoprivrede, šumarstva i vodoprivrede Crne Gore i Upravom za bezbjednost hrane, veterinu i fitosanitarne poslove i ove godine pružiće podršku borbi protiv afričke kuge svinja (AKS), u okviru kampanje koja se realizuje širom Evrope. Četvrtu godinu zaredom, kampanja „Stop afričkoj kugi svinja“ u 18 evropskih zemalja, uključujući i Crnu Goru, podiže...

AKS – SITUACIJA U CRNOJ GORI

Kao što je navedeno, afrička kuga svinja nije zabilježna na teritoriji Crne Gore, ali je rizik od pojave ove bolesti veoma visok, poručuju iz Uprave za bezbjednost hrane, veterinu i fitosanitarne poslove.

Upravo u cilju sprječavanja pojave i ranog otkrivanja, kako još pojašnjavaju, sprovode se aktivnosti koje su usmjerene na prevenciju odnosno na mjere za sprječavanje pojave, kao i pojačani nadzor domaćih i divljih svinja i rigorozna kontrola uvoza svinja i proizvoda dobijenih od svinja na granični inspekcijским mjestima.

„Na snazi je Naredba o zabrani uvoza i tranzita poštijki živih domaćih i divljih svinja mesa i proizvod od svinja radi sprječavanja unošenja opasne zarazne bolesti afričke kuge svinja (”SŠ list CG”, br. 70/11 kojom je propisana zabrana uvoza domaćih i divljih svinja, kao i uslovi za bezbjedan uvoz odnosno stavljanje na tržište Crne Gore proizvoda porijeklom od domaćih i divljih svinja iz država odnosno područja država u kojima je potvrđena ova bolest, a u skladu sa praksom zemalja Evropske unije i Svjetske organizacije za zdravlje životinja kada je u pitanju afrička kuga svinja”, dodaju iz Uprave.

Napominju da se nastavlja sa održavanjem radionica i obuka za veterinare, lovce i držaoc svinja, raspodjelom brošura i informativnog materijala, te da je u toku i sprovođenje kampanje ”Stop afričkoj kugi svinja” koju četvrtu godinu zaredom sprovodi EFSA (Evropska agencija za bezbjednost hrane).

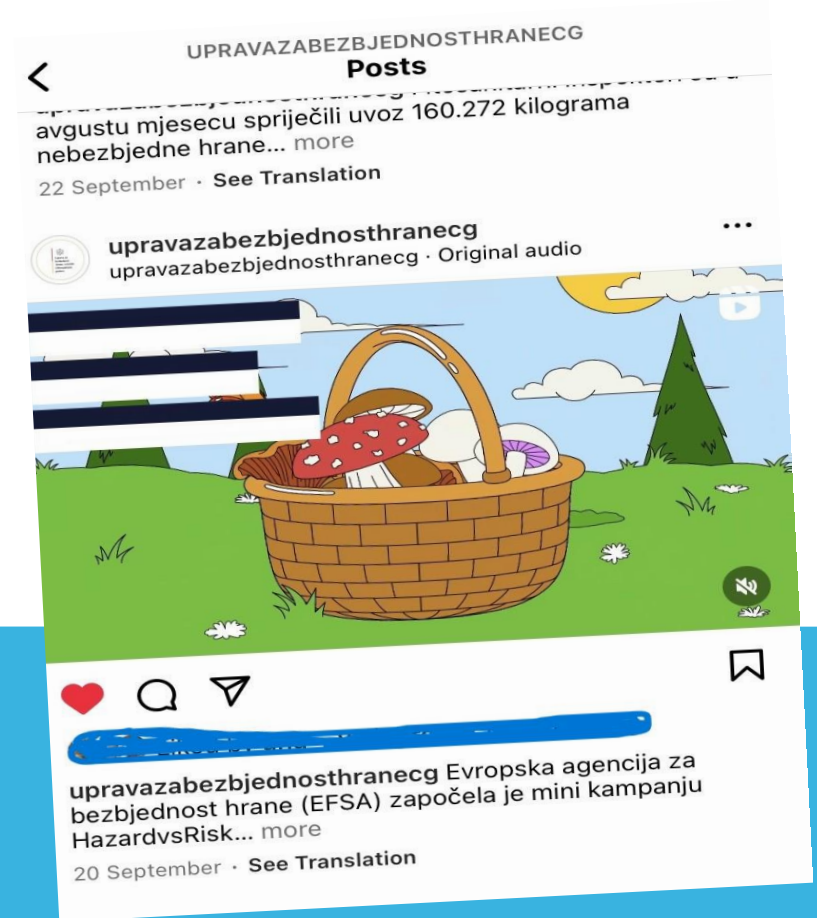
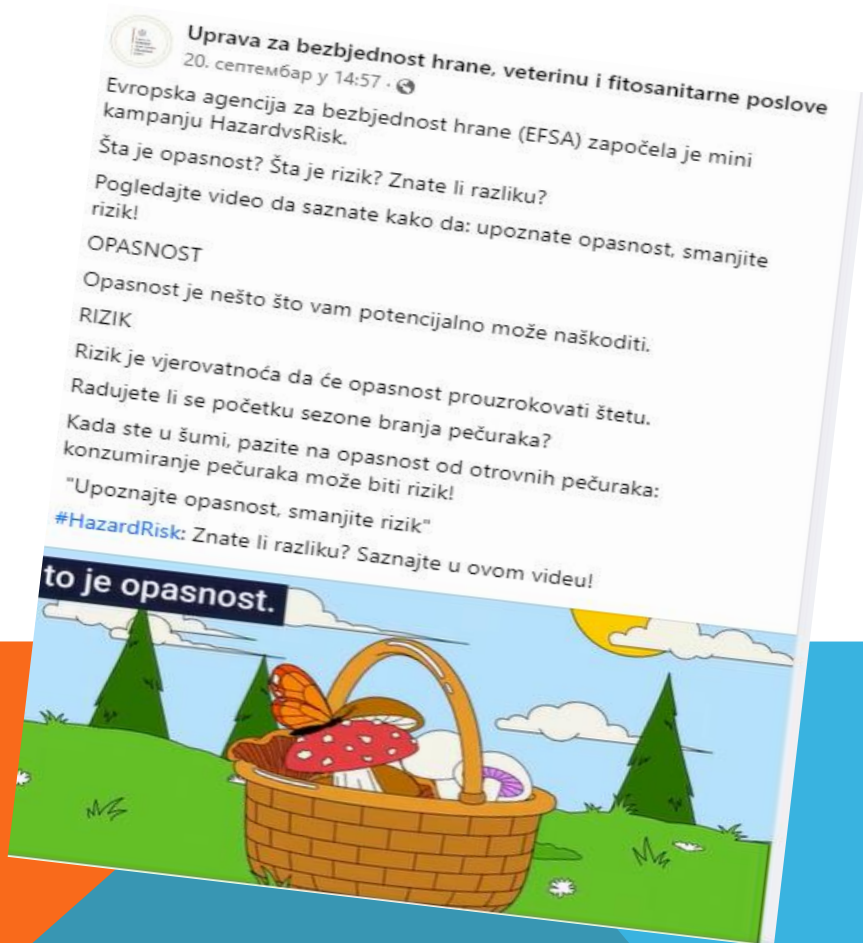
