EFSA AI TASKFORCE – WHAT IT IS ABOUT

AI Taskforce

- A one-stop-shop for AI at EFSA (independent of use case)
- It will be **temporary**, and during its runtime it will identify incremental actions that EFSA can undertake towards exploiting the power of emerging technologies, like AI
- The objective is to employ AI to deliver **positive outcomes** for EFSA and its ecosystems, while **mitigating the risks** these technologies represent
- In particular, the taskforce will expand on the topic of AI Governance across different dimensions and make sure that colleagues are better equipped to advance their AI efforts and that the organization is working **efficiently, collaboratively** and with **accountability to our ecosystem**
- It is anticipated that by the end of 2024 the Taskforce will have gathered consensus around a set of **lighthouse principles** and definitions towards EFSA 's AI approach and a **preliminary use guidance** on these emerging tools
- The Taskforce will report to the MT at its monthly meetings and, yearly, to EFSA, by publishing a report of the work done. However, **continuous conversation** with the internal EFSA ecosystem will be maintained through the sharepoint microsite



EFSA AI TASKFORCE – INITIAL OBJECTIVES



1. WEAVE

What it takes to unlock an AI-ready EFSA, not just as a provider of solutions, but as part of an 'AI-ready' ecosystem (AGoD, EU Agencies, and beyond)



2. TRANSFORM

Identify and support the incremental, transformative actions brought forward by AI that might trigger a bigger organizational change



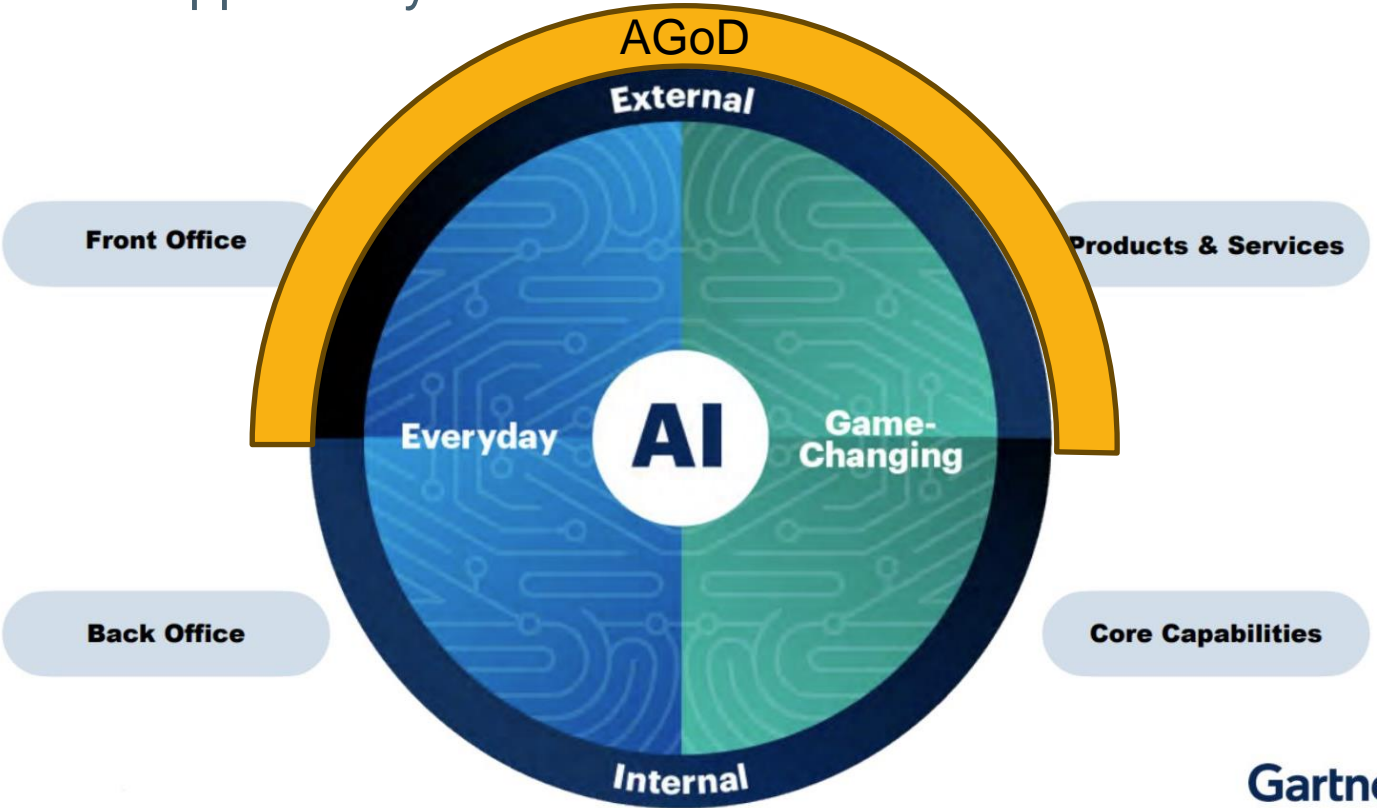
3. ORIENT

Big questions (ethical concerns, security, authority and authorship, human interface/interactions etc). Build a preliminary compass to orient our decision-making

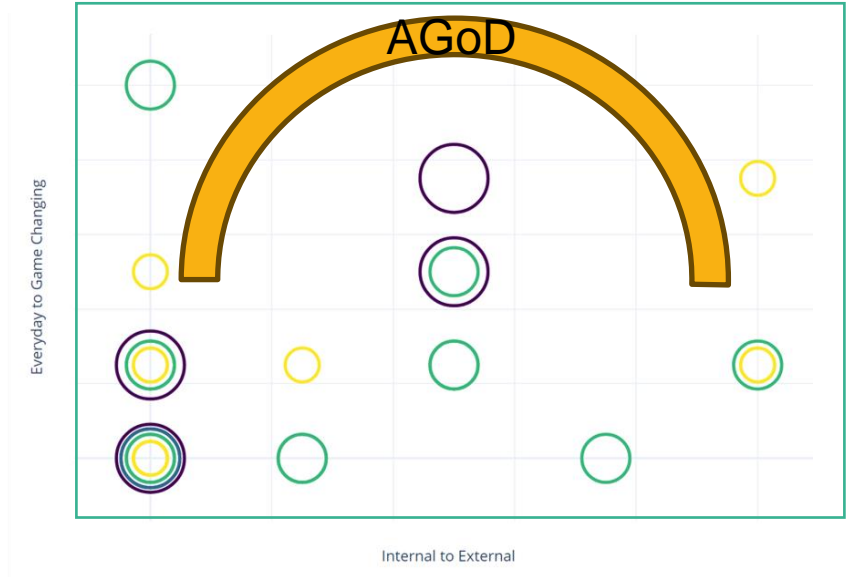


AGOD AND AI @EFSA

Maturity: Low to High



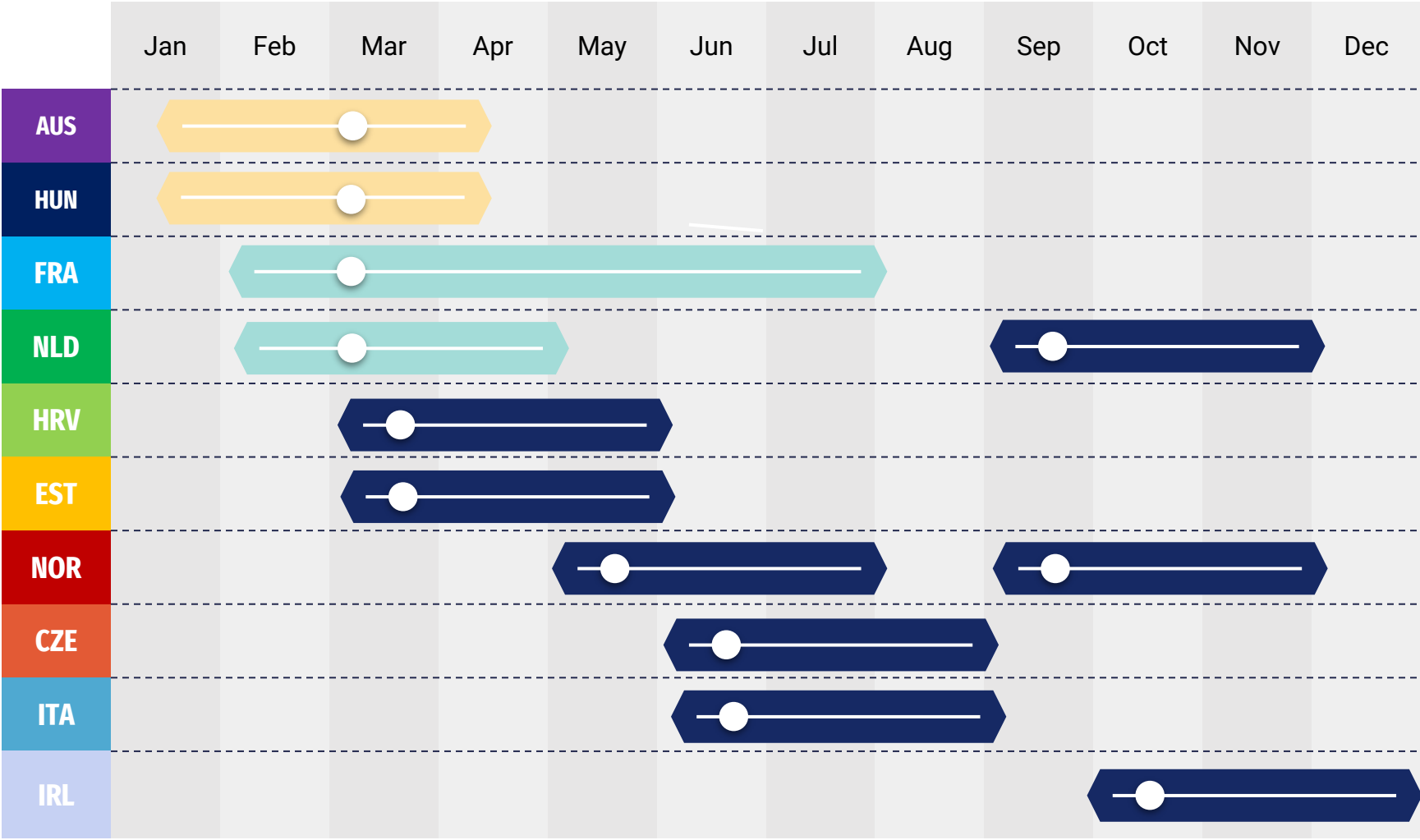

High level Gantt Chart

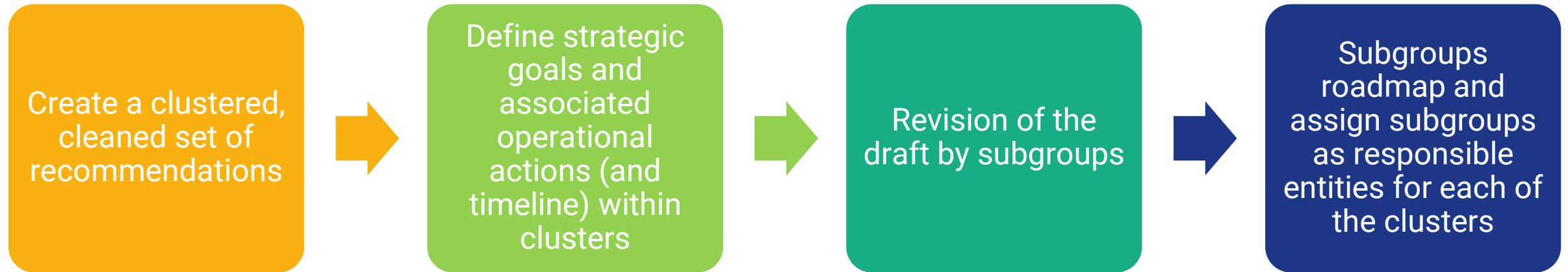


WHY ARE WE REVISITING THE RECOMMENDATIONS?

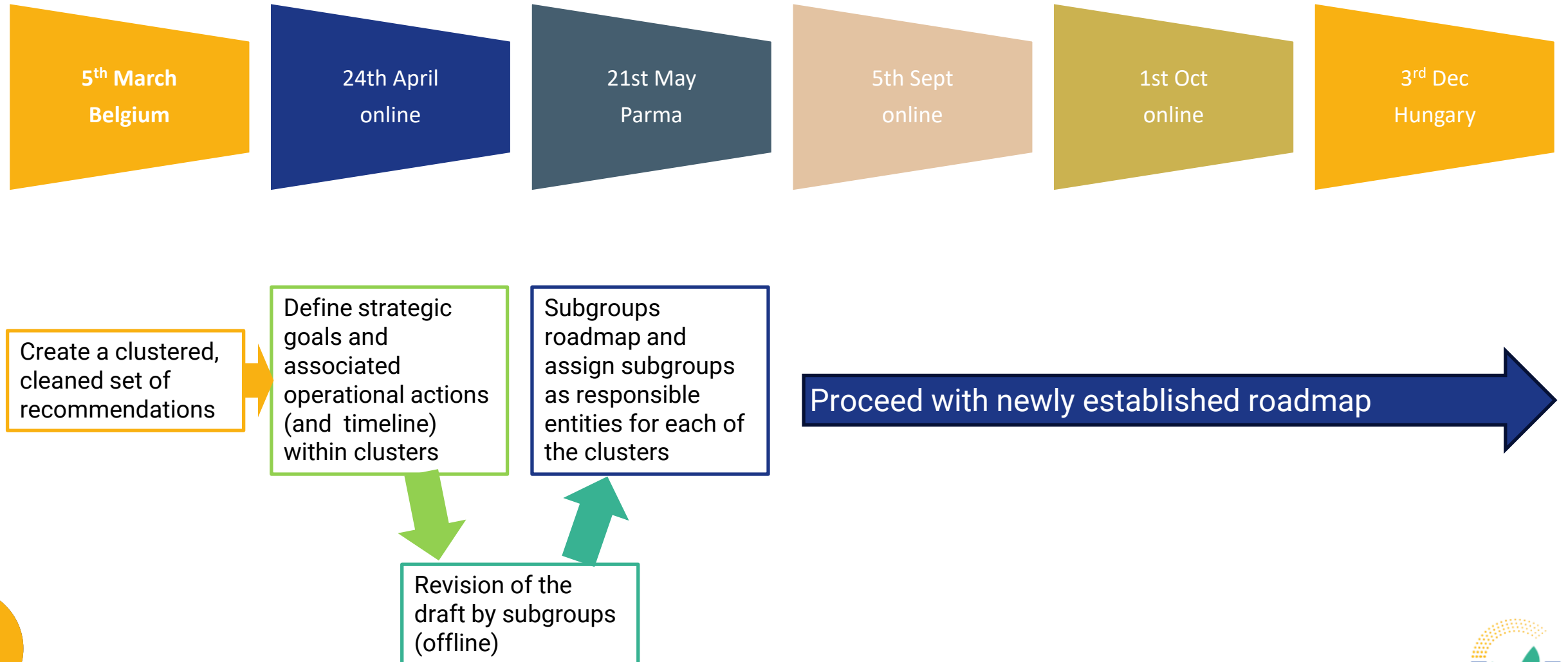
- A new AGoD mandate begins

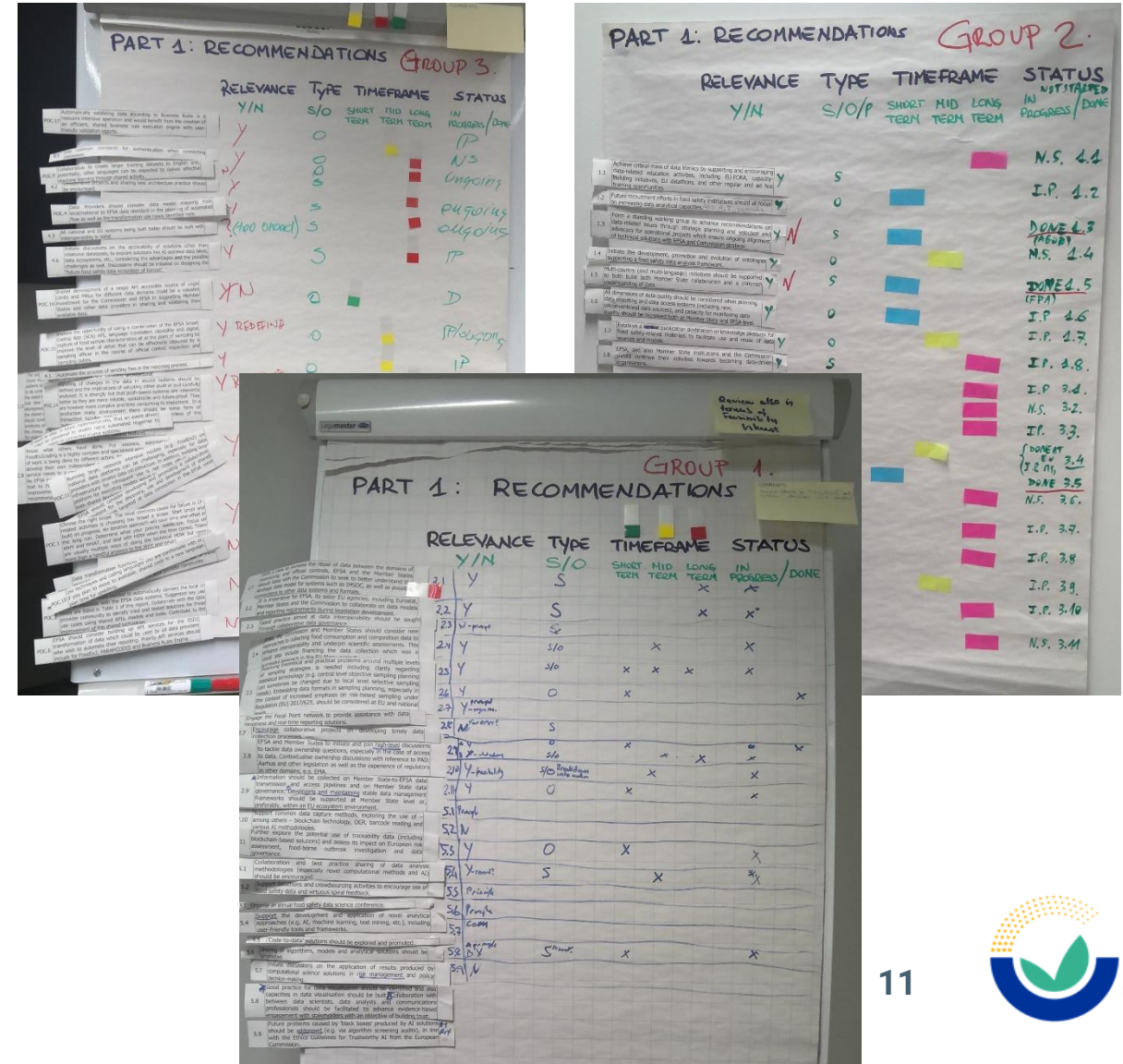
WORKSHOP IN BRUSSELS

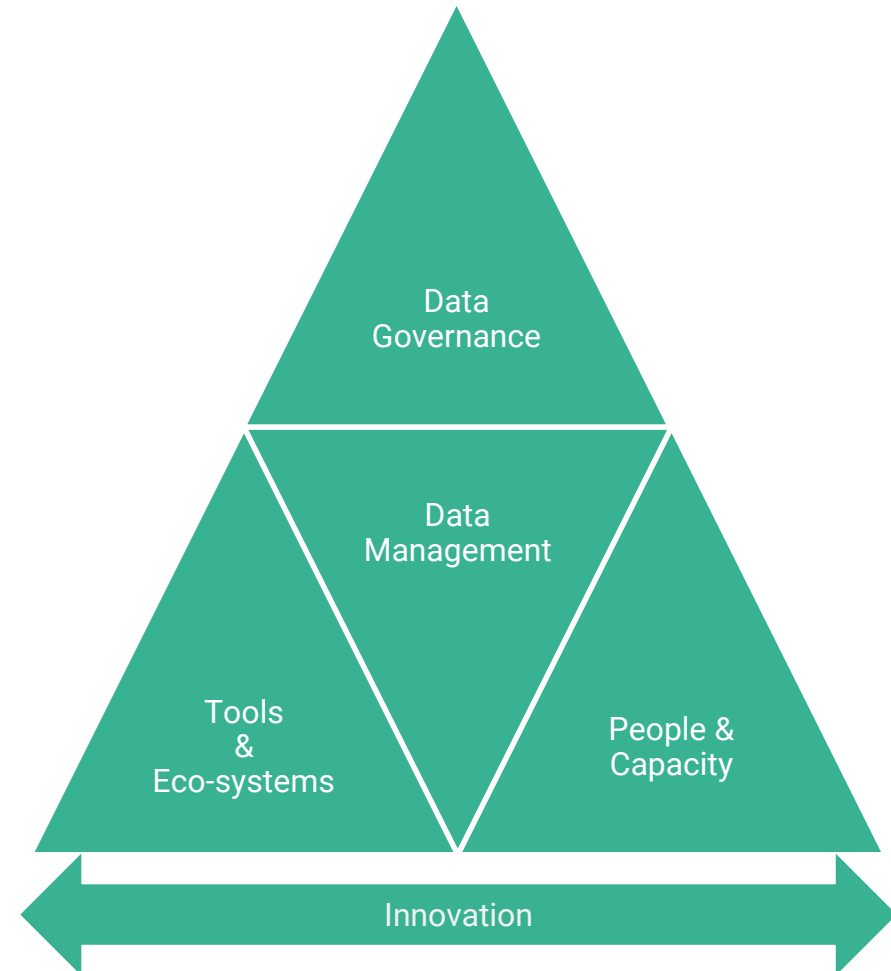
