For the protocol related to the assessment of the safety of plant preparations containing berberine, the assessment of the exposure to berberine was rediscussed and some amendments were proposed. Specific discussions took place on the evidence needs for answering the risk assessment questions for both protocols. The draft protocols will be submitted to the NDA Panel for endorsement for public consultation during its meeting on 27 April 2023.
