6. The Executive Director (ED) meets the PPR Panel

The EFSA ED met the PPR Panel to thank the Panel for the last six years of work and commitment before the end of its mandate.

7. Scientific topic(s) for discussion

7.1. Draft opinion concerning the basic substances chitosan and chitosan hydrochloride (<u>EFSA-Q-2024-00037</u>)

The Panel was updated on the main outcome of the 1^{st} meeting of the Working Group, focusing on the interpretation of the terms of reference. Planning and dates of future meeting were also presented.

7.2. Waiving the dog studies in the regulatory process for agrochemical approval

The Panel was updated on the self-task mandate on the developmental activity on the waiving of dog studies in the risk assessment of pesticides. The chair, in accordance with the internal standard procedure, agreed that a new Working Group is needed for addressing the mandate.

7.3. Application of PBK modelling for the QIVIVE of DNT IVB data for pesticide active substances

The Panel was updated on the self-task mandate for a developmental activity on the use of PBK modelling for quantitative interpretation of Developmental Neurotoxicity (DNT) In Vitro Testing Battery (IVB) data. The chair, in accordance with the internal standard procedure, agreed that a new Working Group is needed for addressing the mandate.

8. EFSA technical report on Development of a DNT AOP using voltage gate sodium channel inhibition as a molecular initiating event (EFSA-Q-2021-00443)

The Panel was updated on the recent progresses made by the Working Group. The Report will be finalised and presented for possible endorsement during the plenary meeting in June. Marina Marinovich was nominated to act as Panel reviewer of the draft Report.

9. Guidance on the use of biomarkers of effect in regulatory risk assessment of chemicals (<u>EFSA-Q-2023-00583</u>)

The Panel was updated on the status of the activities for the development of a Guidance on the use of biomarkers of effect in risk assessment of chemicals and the survey launched in this context. These activities are implemented by a WG established under the Scientific Committee.

10. AOB

The Panel was informed about a call for expression of interest for experts in the area of terrestrial environmental risk assessment. The call is aimed at establishing a pool of experts supporting EFSA with the upcoming mandate on the revision of the SANCO Guidance on terrestrial ecotoxicology (EC, 2002). The chair, in accordance with the internal standard procedure, agreed that a new Working Group is needed for addressing the mandate.
