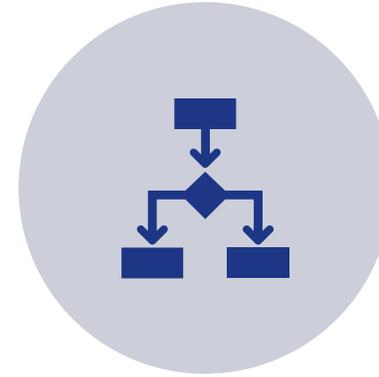

OECD Activity 1

Activity 1 (Overview)

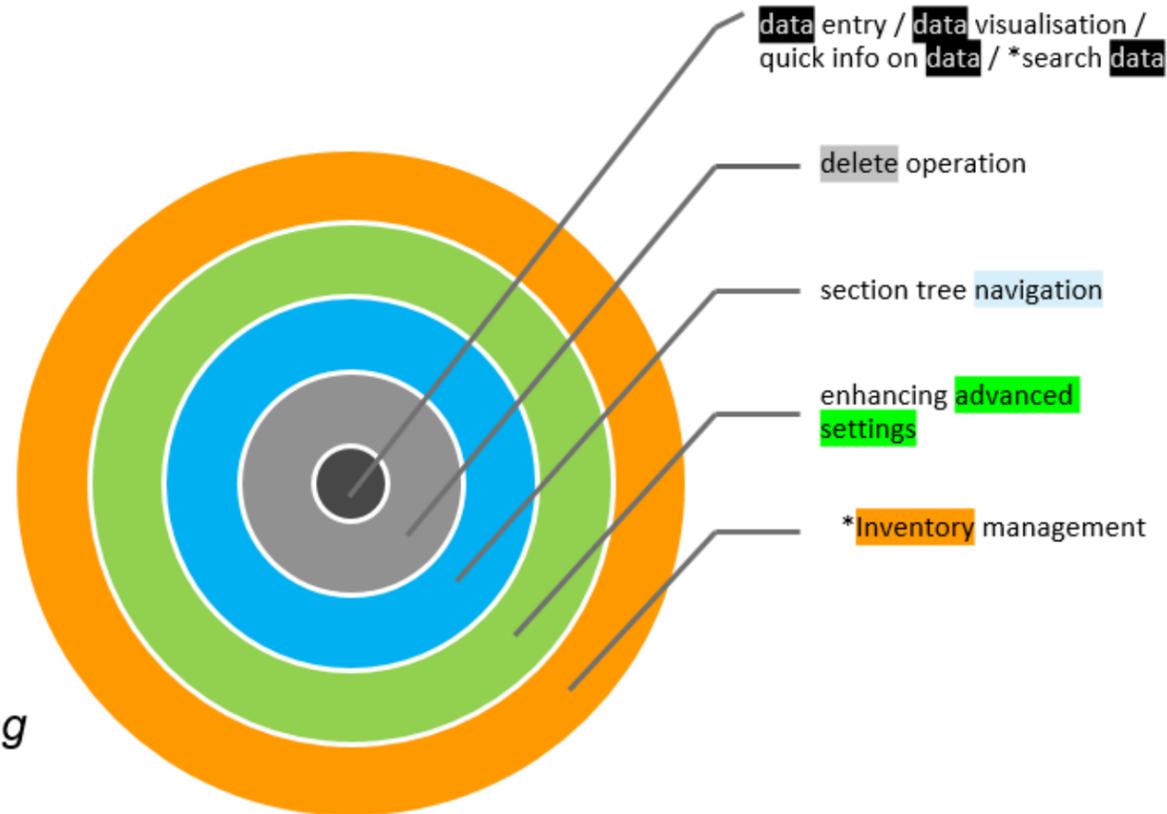
- 10 organisations involved
 - 5 authorities (AICIS, BfR, ECHA, EFSA, NZ EPA)
 - 5 industry (ARCHE Cons., CEFIC, Croplife Europe, Evonik, Eurofins)
- 5 meetings to date (~8hrs meeting time)
- We have now completed the prioritisation of 39 requirements/problem statements
- The top ten requirements/problem statements were initially prioritised
- We expect to have ~2-3 more meetings before the Plenary session (depending on progress)
 - Next meeting 11th June



ACTIVITY #1 – USER INTERFACE IMPROVEMENTS

Activity 1 (Prioritisation)

- Each organisation got one vote
- 5 Authorities and 5 Industry views reflected
- Broad range of prioritised requirements/problem statements
- Top ten chosen – *next meeting to confirm if anything omitted which should not be*

1. Key Areas identified



Data Standardization

Objective

Ensure that data and data formats are harmonised, promoting compatibility with regulatory requirements across diverse chemical legislations/jurisdictions.



Data Validation and Compliance

Objective

Map ideas for data validation tools to ensure the accuracy, consistency and compliance of the data inserted into IUCLID data set.



Language Barrier

Objective

Evaluate the current capabilities of language translation within IUCLID and explore ways to enhance automatic translation, facilitating submissions to various regulatory authorities in accordance with national languages

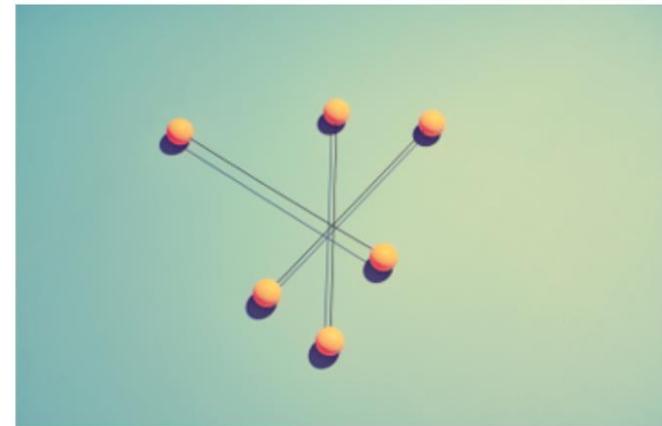
3. Data Validation and compliance
