MEETING MINUTES – 1 July 2023 1st WG meeting on CPEs in the food chain



EFSA provided an introductory presentation on: a) the remit and governance of EFSA and the way the scientific advice is produced; b) administrative and logistical matters, the use of Microsoft Teams as the platform for communications and repository of data and documents during the lifespan of the mandate; c) uncertainty and protocol development guidance documents to be followed and d) the work plan, meetings planned and technical and scientific support provided by EFSA. EFSA staff and the chair of the WG presented the background and Terms of Reference (ToR) of the BIOHAZ Panel self-task Mandate to the WG and clarifications of the ToRs were done.

The current scientific opinion, Part 1, with deadline March 2025, will cover the state of the art of CPEs in the food chain, addressing ToR1 and the review of the new scientific literature mentioned in ToR3. The first steps for protocol development: the problem formulation (step 1) and the planning of the methods to conduct the assessment (step 2) were initiated using a brainstorming session. Information will be gathered by means of a review of the literature and data available since the previous EFSA 2013 opinion on the topic⁴, and surveys targeting the MS/EFTA countries participating in the AMR Monitoring.

Leaders and contributors to the different parts of the risk assessment were assigned and tasks were allocated to EFSA staff and WG experts. A timeline for BIOHAZ Panel Plenaries and WG meetings in 2024 was presented.
