## Revision of SANCO Terrestrial Guidance

- Review the risk assessment for NTAs

Consider the possibility for recovery & recolonisation



- Revise the risk assessment for in-soil organisms

In soil meso and macrofauna and nitrogen transformation rate



- Review the risk assessment for NTTPs

Only NTTPs outside the treated area



## Indirect effects

Develop a methodology for risks from indirect effects on biodiversity via trophic interactions under agro-environmental conditions



Include recommendations for measures and agronomic practices

**Fit-for-purpose** methodologies while being feasible and proportionate



Provide the necessary support to risk managers for the setting of **specific protection goals**



**Consider** the Compendium of conditions of use to reduce exposure and risks from PPPs

## Specific objectives

- Gather preliminary feedback from various stakeholders on the current guidance document and its challenges
- Identify and share current knowledge and information on available data and test guidelines
- Facilitate discussions to outline expectations and priorities for the revised guidance document

## Organisation

- 2 Plenary sessions for feedback from academia, MS & stakeholders & breakout groups
- 5 breakout groups on NTAs, NTPPs, in-soil organisms, exposure and indirect effects
- 68 registrants

**Next step: draft outline to be finalized by 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025**



# Open call for an FPA

- Call Title : **Support for the revision of the guidance document on terrestrial ecotoxicology (SANCO/10329/2002) including the development of an approach for indirect effects**
- Launch date: end of October
- Deadline date: end of January
- Budget: **1 Million**
- Scope of the call (short description): to identify partners among Competent Organisations of Art. 36 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 which can support EFSA Working Group in addressing the mandate on the revision of Terrestrial Ecotoxicology Guidance Document (SANCO/10329/2002) for plant protection products and the mandate for developing an approach to assess potential indirect effects of pesticides on biodiversity via trophic interactions under agro-environmental conditions in the context of the Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009.
- **Duration of the FPA: 4y**
- It will be published on the Funding and Tenders Portal (<https://ec.europa.eu/info/funding-tenders/opportunities/portal/screen/home>) on the 31/10. An email will also be sent to Article 36 organisations
