 Via call circulated by e-mail with AF and FP on 13 January and 6 February.

Examples of topics of interest for MSs

Procedural aspects: e.g. relevant for MS representatives involved in the receipt of application dossiers or other phases of the application procedure.

Digital tools: e.g. tools used by MSs representatives, such as ESFC, Connect.EFSA for consultations,...

Affiliation of MS delegates

Where necessary, possible for MSs to identify also experts from competent organisations acting on behalf of MS national authorities, also on an ad hoc basis.

Latvia (Latvija, LV)

The <u>Ministry of Agriculture</u> is the central source of data related to animal diseases and to animal population in Latvia. The Ministry of Agriculture is responsible for the development of the policy on agriculture, fishery and forest domain of rural economy.

The <u>Food and Veterinary Service (FVS)</u> via the Veterinary Surveillance Department is mainly involved in the collection and management of the data regarding: outbreaks and the surveillance activities of the disease control (LSD, ASF, AI).

The Food and Veterinary Service (FVS) via Food Surveillance Department is mainly involved in data collection and registration of establishments (assembly centres, genetic centres, hatcheries and slaughterhouses) and maintenance of database.

The <u>Agricultural Data Centre</u> is mainly involved with the collection and management of the data regarding: the animal population, establishments and premises where live animals are kept.

While the <u>Institute of Food Safety</u>, <u>Animal Health and Environment (BIOR)</u> is also involved with the data on laboratory results regarding the diseases.


In Latvia different regional and local authorities are also participating to the collection and management of the data at primary level in order to make them available to the central authorities.

The location of the Ministry of Agriculture, the Food Veterinary Service, the Agricultural Data Centre and the Institute of Food Safety, Animal Health and Environment (BIOR) is in Riga.




Figure 7: Country Data Ownership Map for Latvia's VMPR, Contaminants Occurrence, Prevalence of zoonoses and pathogens and Food Consumption business data collections³




Area 1. Knowledge and information management and support to scientific production



FP, upon dissemination requests submitted from EFSA and/or other FP, shares the information with relevant national actors through the use of available channels (e.g., outlook, Teams, FP webpages, national webpages, social media platforms, newsletters, ...) and keep dissemination channels up to date (when needed).

FP provides support to the national representatives in the **Advisory Forum**.







FP liaises with organisations and facilitates the processes of inclusion in the **competent organisation list (Art. 36)** at national level and with EFSA, in line with described procedures and through the use of the available tool. FP support the organisations on the list and ensures that they meet the criteria and that the information in the profiles is updated regularly, at least every 3 years.

FP coordinates with the AF member in the identification and the nomination process of national representatives in EFSA's Scientific Networks and ad-hoc experts following EFSA procedures (e.g., for AFDG's, task forces, workshops etc.).






FP establishes contacts with the national contact point for BTSF training with the aim to support the selection of the most relevant participants for the BTSF training sessions on risk assessment.



FP is knowledgeable of national experts responsible and involved in data reporting (e.g., reporting officers, data providers) and FP facilitates two way communication between EFSA-national experts and among national experts when support is needed and on cross-cutting issues.





In close cooperation with the Communication Expert Network (CEN) representatives and through the use of tools available to FP's in their organisations, FP supports communication initiatives that raise EFSA's visibility and outreach (e.g., through use of national webpages, social media, printed or e-media material such as newsletters, factsheets, and infographics).
