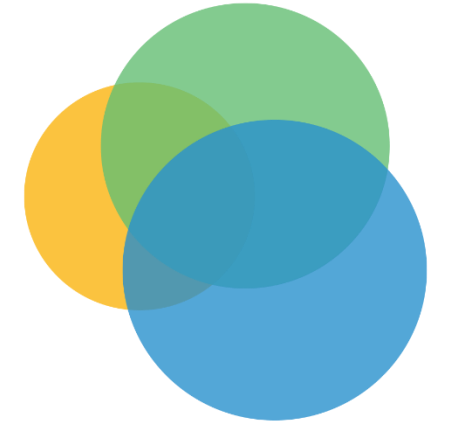

xORA - eXcellent One Health Risk Assessment education

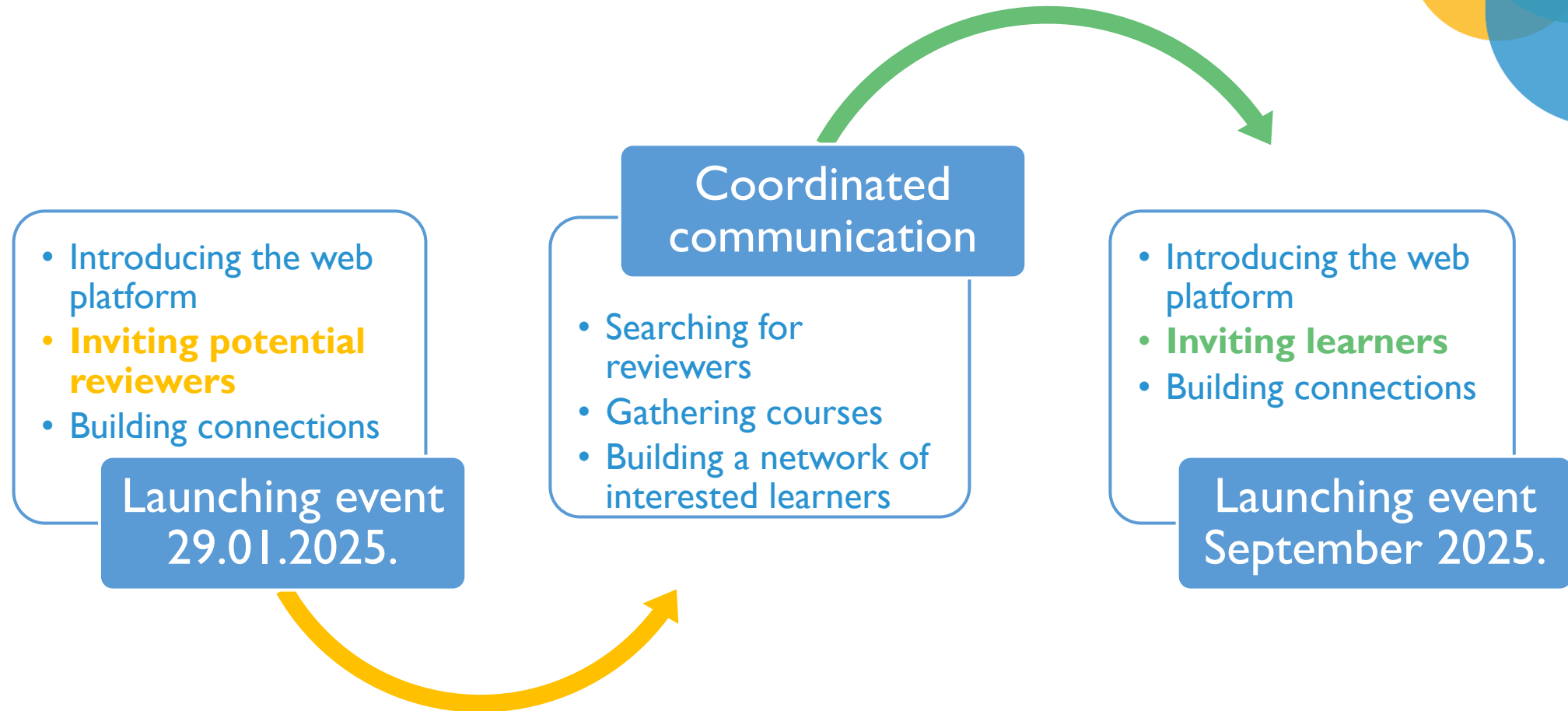

What is BTSF?

BTSF: Better training for safer food

A DG SANTE **training initiative** since 2005 for EU/EEA* and non-EU official control staff, sometimes stakeholders

Objective: High levels of competence and knowledge of EU/EEA* rules leading to harmonised approach to control systems and enforcement, facilitating trade and market access

Principles

- Train the Trainer
- Multi-lingual Training Dissemination
- Knowledge/experience sharing and networking Commission approves training material submitted by contractor

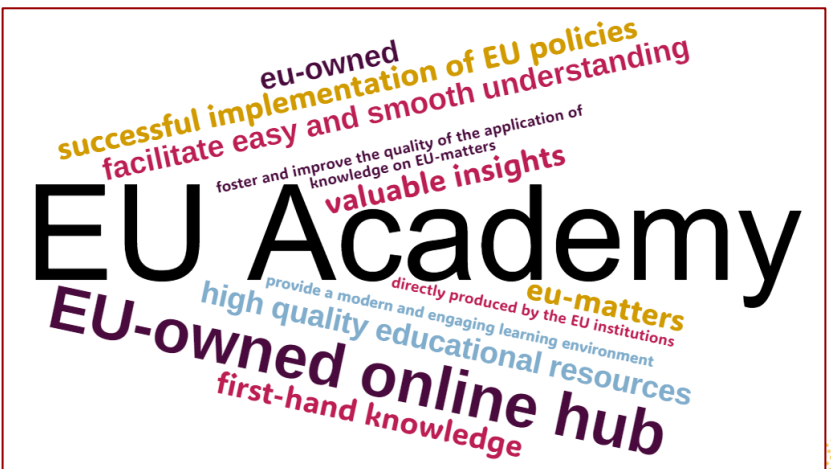
Current main activities:

integrated parts of capacity building

- **Understanding need**
 - MS's capacity varies, and have different needs and levels of resources
 - European and international organisations and industry
 - Understanding the needs and facilitating knowledge transfer between experts
- **Existing training platforms:**
 - different the training platforms
 - Actions might be required to connect training platforms
- **Sharing training materials and events**
 - making training information (open events, materials) available through widely used platforms
- **Flexible training formats**
 - artificial Intelligence can be used to create online trainings that are adapted to individual learners' needs and can be expanded to reach larger audiences.

Easier access for staff/employees incl. aspiring and experienced risk assessors to find good quality courses and training

- In the long run
 - more and better qualified risk assessors for EFSA and national organisations
 - more uniform assessments
 - *SAFER FOOD!*

 - FOCUS ON COLLABORATION AND CONNECTION
 - Mapping current and potential future needs for capacity building – and the exciting offers
