BACKGROUND AND STATE OF PLAY

Hexane:

- authorised extraction solvent in the production of food and food ingredients according to directive 2009/32/EC on the basis of SCF assessment (1996).
- extensively used in the extraction of vegetable oil and fats and in proteins production.

2023: mandate to EFSA to assess the need for a safety re-evaluation of hexane

2024: EFSA technical report **concluded that the safety of hexane should be re-evaluated** based on considerations on its identity, uses, exposure and toxicology

2025: EC mandated EFSA to **re-assess hexane as extraction solvent** (deadline 22 November 2027).

Call for data to collect information from stakeholders/interested parties (22 June 2025- 23 October 2025)

Systematic literature review (focused on toxicity data)



PARALLEL ASSESSMENTS

Parallel assessments of hexane by other agencies and MSs were identified:

- Hexane proposal as substance of very high concern (SVHC) under REACH Slovenia
- Possible proposal for Restriction under REACH (to be confirmed) Germany

July 2025: a meeting was held with SI and DE representatives to discuss ways to cooperate and avoid possible scientific divergencies.

Outcome of the meeting:

- Expert sharing (SI will provide neurotox expert to EFSA WG, DE already has an expert from BfR as member of the WG).
- Participation of EFSA to the public consultation of the SVHC report.
- Sharing of the Regulatory management options analysis (RMOA) report, if possible.
- Propose the case for presentation in the 1S1A Expert group meeting.
