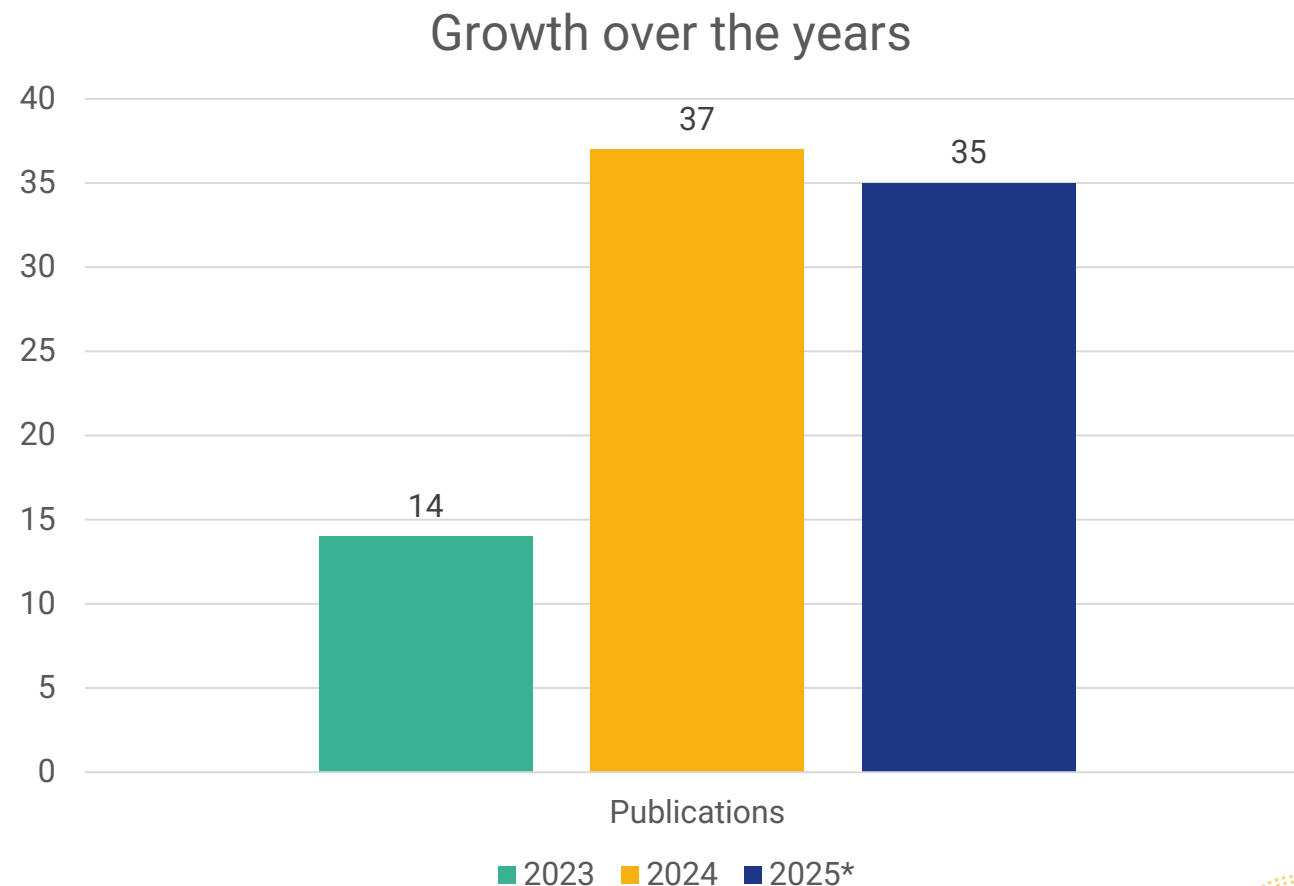


Three years of FRAE: Participation across Europe
