IUCLID – LATEST NEWS & UPDATES



GENERAL UPDATE

- 12 meetings of the **Virtual Tour** with the Member States held so far (AT, DK, GR, FR, NL, IT, ES, FI, DE, SI, LV, **PT**)
 - We will resume in September, invitations to be sent in advance
- **IUCOLID 6.9** went live on 26 May 2025
 - No issues/delays related to the **migration of Cloud accounts**
 - Minor migration issue related to Analytical methods – currently under investigation and will be fixed by October at the latest



IUCOLID MANUALS

- The manuals are being updated and will be published by the end of July at the latest (except micro-organisms, which will be published in the autumn)
- FDP will launch a survey for feedback on the manuals and on the use of test dossiers
 - This will be launched after the summer, the feedback will be analysed and considered as from the 2026 revision
 - For Doc J dismissal a standalone support package is available on the Toolkit

ADMISSIBILITY CHECKLIST FOR PESTICIDES APPLICATIONS

EFSA has recently updated the **Admissibility checklist** (Appendix C) of the 'Administrative guidance on submission of dossiers and assessment reports for the peer-review of pesticide active substances and on the maximum residue level (MRL) application procedure'

 **The updated Admissibility checklist is designed to support both applicants during the preparation of their dossiers, ensuring higher data quality in IUCLID dossiers, and Member States in carrying out the admissibility check**

What's new?

-  Clearer guidance on elements required during completeness check
-  Use of IUCLID report generator during dossier preparation and admissibility check
-  Enforced use of structured data reporting in IUCLID
-  Enhanced alignment with current regulatory expectations

OLD DOSSIERS - REMINDER

- As presented at the 33rd PSN meeting in May 2025, EFSA has observed significant delays in the declaration of admissibility in a number of cases and this has an impact on the overall assessment timeline and planning
- There was a particular focus on dossiers submitted in 2021 – 2022
- Most of these dossiers would require heavy refactoring before resubmission in order to be declared admissible - **EFSA is available to support the respective applicants and RMS** in preparing these resubmissions, provided the RMS commit to process the admissibility within a reasonable timeframe

TEST MATERIAL ENTITY - FILTERING

- **TM_DETAILS** filtering rule:
 - A format change was included in IUCLID 6.9 giving the possibility to flag every individual item confidential within the test material entity (except the AS)
 - The implementation of the amended filtering rule has been delayed to **October 2025** and the flag in the linked Endpoint Study record will continue to be the basis for confidentiality until then
 - For new dossiers applicants are encouraged to also flag within the TM entity (i.e. to use the new flags too) as this will facilitate migration in October



DOCUMENT J DISMISSAL

 - The **Mapping of Doc J** elements to the fields in the IUCLID dossier (i.e. the Crosswalks clarifying in which IUCLID sections/fields to enter the data previously included in Doc J) + ad-hoc instructions are available in the Applicants toolkit:

CONFIDENTIAL REPORT – NEXT STEPS

- EFSA has started working on the “Confidential Report” which is intended to support the RMS in compiling the DAR Vol 4
- As previously announced, the timeline was adjusted due to the delay in IUCLID 6.9 delivery
- As soon as the draft Confidential report is available MS will be:
 - Given access for testing & commenting (before summer)
 - Invited to join dedicated session(s) to ensure that the contents and format of the report fulfil expectations
 - The first info session will be held in September 2025 (more details will follow)



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
