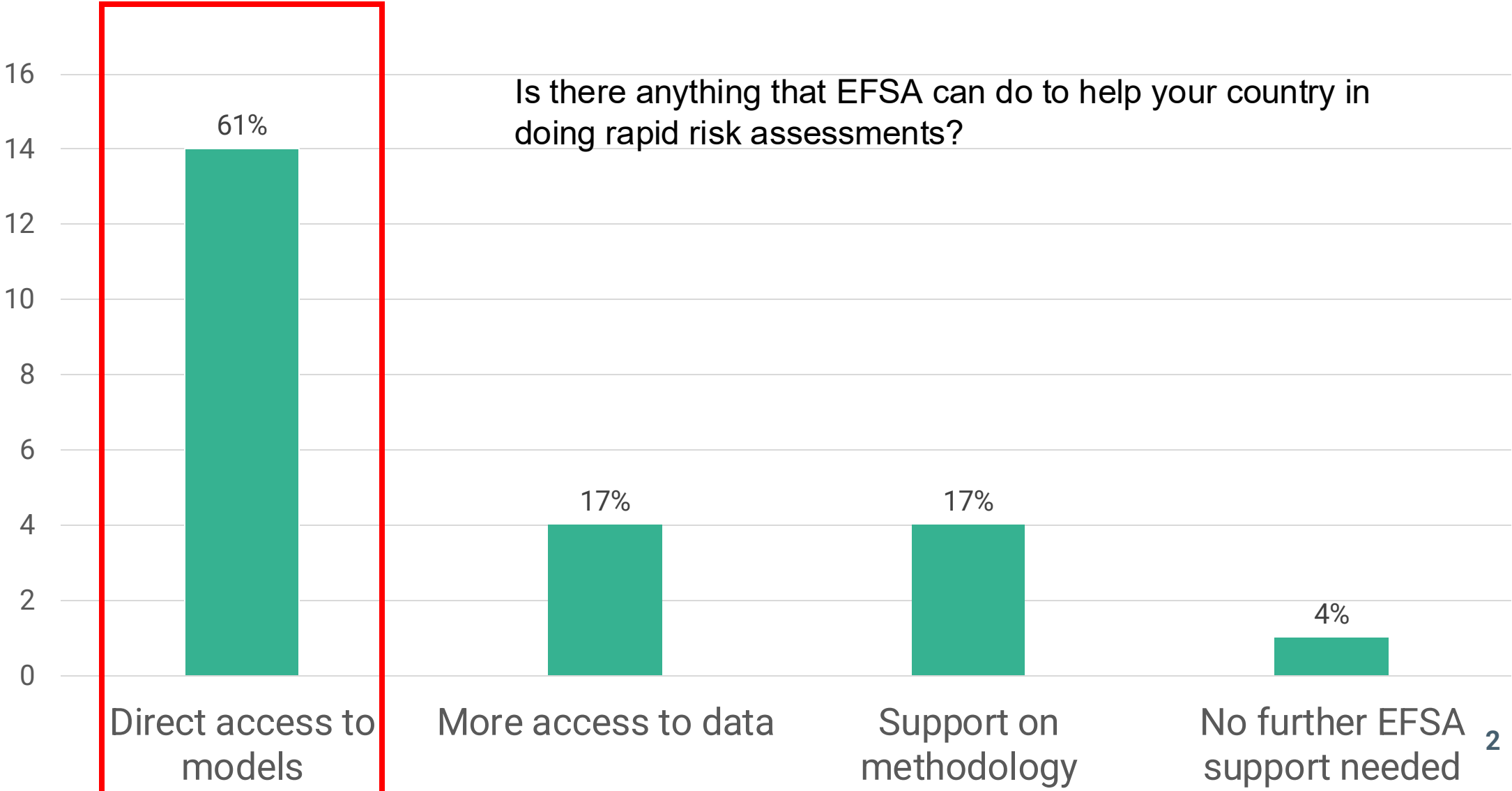




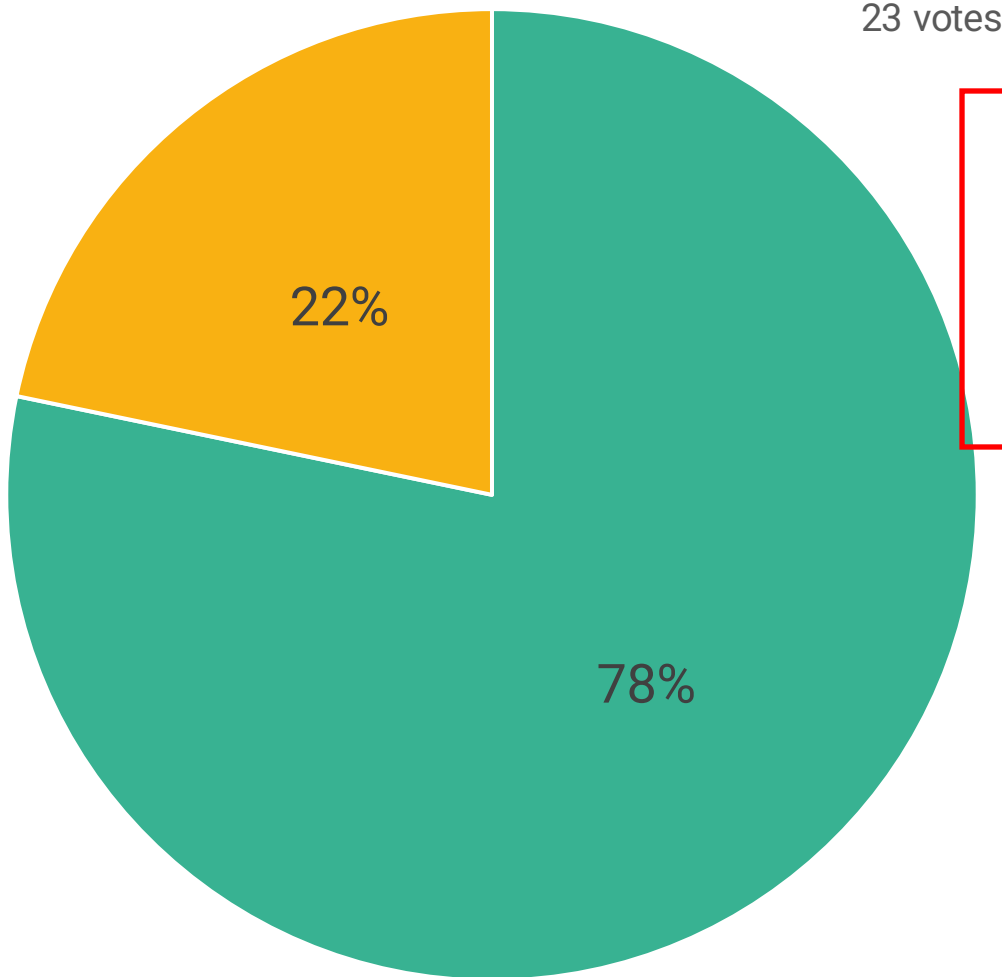

FUTURE EFSA CALL ON MODELLING

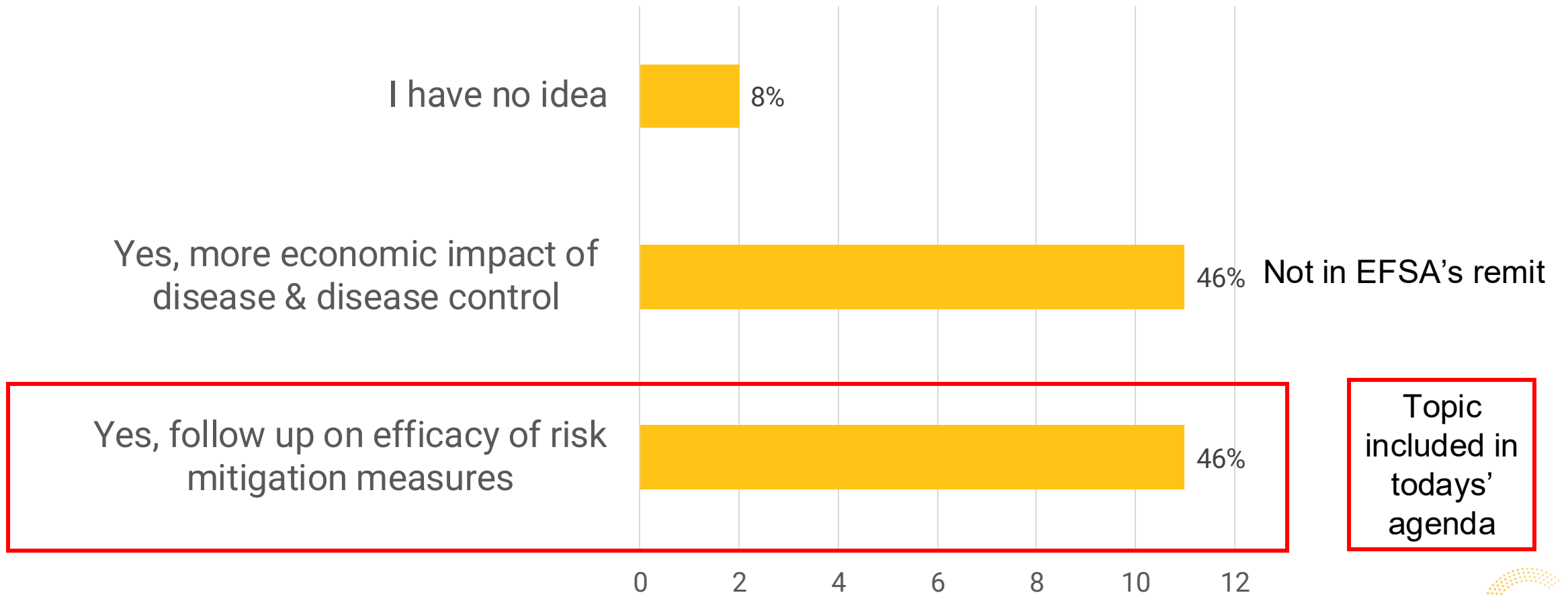
Ideas to be further developed:

- **Define specific questions** that these models can answer (SLIDO questions)



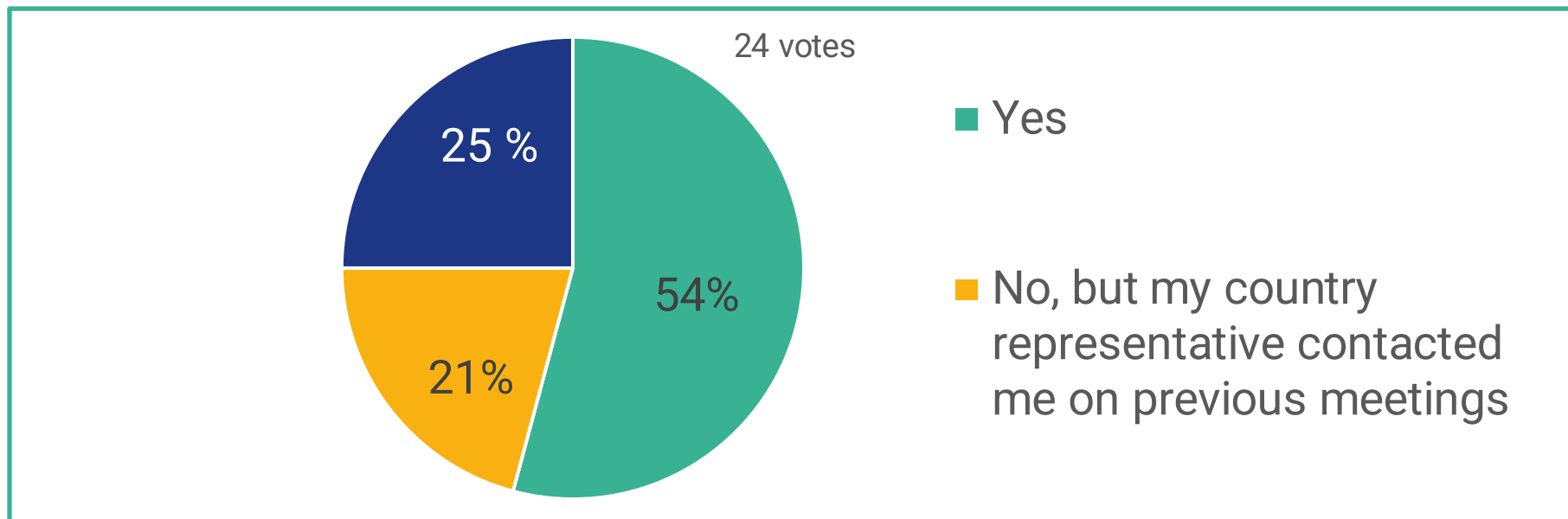
