Andrés Barragán Urbiola (Barcelona, Spain, 1990) is a State Economist. He currently serves as the Secretary-General for Consumer Affairs and Gambling, at the Ministry of Social Rights, Consumer Affairs and Agenda 2030. He has developed his professional career at the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Enterprise, where he held the position of Deputy Director General of Multilateral Development Banks, the IMF and the G20. From 2021 to 2023, he was Chief of Staff of the Public Treasury, and previously an advisor to the Secretary of State for the Economy. He has also served as a director of the Official Credit Institute, and as Spain's official representative to European Union institutions and various international organisations.

He holds a degree in Physics with a specialization in Theoretical Physics (2008-2013) and a degree in Philosophy (2008-2014), both from the Complutense University of Madrid. Since 2017 he has been a career civil servant in the Higher Corps of Commercial Technicians and State Economists. Through different courses he has specialized in financial analysis, economic policy and international institutions.
