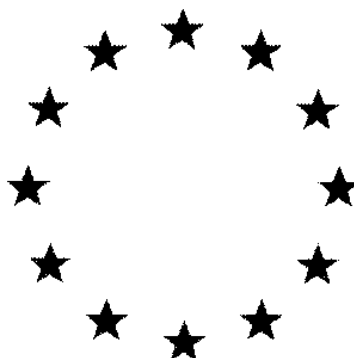

Precautions for safe handling

Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety practice. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Use personal protective equipment as required. Avoid formation of dust and aerosols. Keep away from food, drink and animal feedstuffs. Avoid breathing dust/fumes/gas/mist/vapours/spray.

The following PPE should be used:

Respiratory protection:	In the case of dust or aerosol formation, use respirator with an approved filter.
Hand protection:	Impervious gloves.
Eye protection:	Safety glasses with side shield.
Other skin protection:	Impervious clothing.

Information on storage

Keep in original container; in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place. Keep at temperatures not exceeding 25°C. Protect from contamination. Do not freeze.

Fire-fighting measures

Daminozide is not flammable. In case of fire, use water mist or fog, alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. Do not use a water spray jet. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and suitable protective clothing.

Water used to extinguish a fire should not be allowed to enter the drainage system or watercourses.

Environmental precautions

Do not allow contact with soil, surface water or ground water. Do not empty into drains. Use appropriate containment to avoid environmental contamination. If polluted water, reaches drainage systems or water courses, immediately inform appropriate authorities.

B.4.2 Procedures for destruction and decontamination

Product

Do not discharge into drains or the environment. Disposal should be in accordance with local and national regulations. Incineration by an approved method could be considered.

Packaging:

Dispose of as unused product. Empty containers should be taken to an approved waste handling site for recycling or disposal. Incineration by an approved method could be considered. Do not re-use empty containers.

B.4.3 Emergency measures in the case of accident

First aid measures

After inhalation:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Remove promptly anything of a restrictive nature. Obtain medical advice and have product container or label at hand.
After skin contact:	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash off with warm water and soap. If symptoms persist, obtain medical advice.
After eye contact:	In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water. If symptoms persist, obtain medical advice.
After ingestion:	If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Obtain medical advice.

Accidental release measures

a) Personal precautions

Wear protective clothing (see B.4.1). Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

b) Environmental precautions

Do not allow contact with soil, surface water or ground water. Do not empty into drains. Use appropriate containment to avoid environmental contamination. If polluted water, reaches drainage systems or water courses, immediately inform appropriate authorities.

c) Methods for cleaning up

Pick up and arrange disposal without creating dust. Place in a sealable container. Remove contaminated clothing to a safe location for subsequent disposal. Clean the floor and all contaminated objects with water.
