**Question**: If an organization has registered in the partner search functionality on EU Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal, does this mean they are eligible to apply for EFSA grants?

**Answer:** Identification of a partner with which your organisation could apply for this grant can be facilitated by the use of the *PARTNER SEARCH ANNOUCEMENTS* functionality in the EU Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal (see screen shot below).

LEARs, Account Administrators or self-registrants can publish partner requests for open and forthcoming topics after logging into this Portal, as well as any user having an active public Person profile.

In accordance with section 1.5 and 2.2 of the Call for proposals, <u>applicants</u> (coordinator and partner in the consortium) must be included in the <u>Article 36 list of eligible organisations</u>. Applications made by consortium in which partners are not on the Article 36 list will be excluded.

Applicants should note that if a potential partner is identified via the partner search functionality (either through Expertise Offer or Expertise Request) in the EU Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal, it is their responsibility to check that the potential partner organisation is included on the Article 36 list of eligible organisations. EFSA takes no responsibility for checking whether the organisations which have registered in the partner search functionality, are eligible to apply for EFSA grants.
