Question:

For this project is possible to know:

- amount of financing;
- if co-financing is necessary;

Answer:

- The amount of financing is:

for Lot 1: 300.000 euros

for Lot 2 and 3: foreseen up to a total of 5.000.000 euros with possibility to award several grants of 500.000 euros each covering one case study, or a higher amount in case of grants covering several case studies.

- The co-financing principle is not applicable principle for this type of grant.
- To be eligible, the applicant and in case of a consortium the partner/s must be on the list of competent organisations designated by the Member States in accordance with Article 36 of Regulation (EC) 178/2002 and Commission Regulation (EC) 2230/2004. In case the University you are referring to is not on the short list, it cannot be included as partner, but as subcontractor, then exclusively to execute ancillary tasks.
