CLARIFICATION N°1

Call reference: GP/EFSA/PLANTS/2022/04

Call title: Experimental and observational evidence to reduce knowledge gaps on Xylella fastidiosa

and its vectors

Question 1: The call states that the project may be up to 4 years maximum. The applicant is interpreting that a 3-year project would be acceptable. Is that interpretation correct?

Answer: For both Lots, the maximum duration of the projects to be awarded under this Call is 4 years. A shorter duration (e.g. 3 years) is acceptable, provided that the specific objectives can be realistically achieved within the proposed timeframe.

Question 2: Could an organisations that are not on the Art. 36 list at the time of the deadline for proposals take part to the project?

Answer 2: Any applicant applying as Coordinator or(co)beneficiary must be on the Art.36 short list at the deadline set for submission of the proposals. Further information is available under point 1.4 and 1.5 of the call for proposal.

Regarding possibility and conditions for subcontracting, please refer to point 1.6 of the call for proposal, for example: Core tasks, such as project coordination, cannot be subcontracted.
