Title: Design of an Artificial Intelligence solution to detect fake news using EFSA's body of scientific opinions to safeguard the credibility of information in EU about food and feed safety

Question 1:

Is it possible to have the list of the participating teams in order to ask to join a team?

Answer 1:

The registration of the applicants is currently ongoing. The deadline for registration is 28th January 2021 at 14:30 CET and the rules for registration are highlighted in the rules of contest (page 6) and in the clarification n. 1 published on [EFSA website](#). After the deadline for registration, all registered participants will receive an invitation to access, on a voluntary basis, an Hackathon platform which will allow interaction, collaboration and matchmaking between applicants. Contestants can decide to join or not the collaborative Hackathon platform, on an optional basis.

Question 2:

In case of individual participation is it possible to submit a previous project, thesis, or publication?

Answer 2:

Applicants can re-use or build up on existing work, by properly referencing to it. However, please observe that we are looking for innovative solutions. Be reminded that one of the 5 award criteria against which the submitted material will be evaluated is "originality" (award criteria 3, page 7 of the rules of contest).
