² **Former EFSA (statutory staff):** should not be awarded ISA contracts if they are in receipt of unemployment allowance from the Union Budget.

Retired EFSA staff member (statutory staff): the value of signed contracts in a given year (i.e. the year in which new ISA contract will be signed) under article 237 of the EU Financial Regulation may not exceed the difference between the total annual gross income from the last full year of employment and the annual gross pension for the calendar year in which a new ISA contract will be signed.
