EU-FORA CONCEPT

15 fellows per 12-month cycle

- Learning-by-doing in the fellow hosting sites for 1 year
- Specific and uniform RA training programme:
 - A three-week introductory programme at EFSA
 - three (3) one-week training modules hosted by different national authorities

ROLE OF THE EU-FORA PROGRAMME COMMITTEE

Design the entire programme and set up

Analyse lessons learnt and define adjustment actions



Define learning objectives, structure and content of training modules

EU-FORA GOVERNANCE

Select the Fellow hosting sites

Liaise with the fellows and supervisors in each hosting site

Programme manager & Scientific Coordinator

Shortlist the Fellow candidates

Match the 15 fellows with the 15 selected hosting sites work programmes



RESULTS OF CALLS FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

- 85 fellow candidate applications coming from 21 different member states
- □ **34** proposals for becoming hosting site from **18** different member states



Close to **100% of the Member States** have expressed interest





EU- FORA FELLOW SET UP PHASE

March

- 72 fellow applicants interviewed
- 30 shortlisted

April

- 34 hosting site work programmes evaluated
- 15 selected

May


- Matching 30 candidates with 15 work programmes
