- Start-up Phase of a Global Platform for Food Risk Communicators – Working Group, Define ToR
- Plan for Improving & Preparing for Diverging Views
- EU Insights research and EU-wide comms strategy

- The AFCWG identified 3 priority topics:
 - Antimicrobial Resistance (all 3 groups identified this as a key topic)
 - Pesticides
 - Food Supplements
- The AF is requested to make final selection of the topic for the 2016 survey and EUwide Communications strategy
